Check-In Procedures

Location: Memorial Hall @ 6pm

- *You will be asked to Check-In your camper, this includes asking about any current illnesses, a temperature check and medication to be turned in.
- *Any medication is required to be in their original containers with pharmacy instructions. We cannot except medicine in baggies.
- *You will also write on the Check-In card who is picking up your camper.
- *Camper will then go to their assigned housing with parent(s) to unpack.

Check-Out Procedures

Location: Memorial Hall Lobby @ 1pm

- *Sign your camper out in the Lobby of Memorial Hall, from there you will be directed to the Dining Hall.
- *Your camper will be waiting at 1:00pm in the Dining Hall.
- *After you have signed out your camper, you will proceed to the meeting area and will be met at the door by Camp Staff who will match the right camper with the right parent.
- *You may then take your camper home.

What to Pack

- Bible, notebook, pen/pencil
- Water Bottle (labeled w/ name)
- Clothes: jeans, t-shirt, sweatshirt(s), tennis shoes, socks, underwear, jacket, pajamas, coat, hat, gloves, snow boots (depending on weather)
- Bedding: sleeping bag or sheets, blanket and pillow
- Toiletries: towel, wash cloth, personal hygiene items
- **Cell Phones and all electronic equipment are NOT permitted at camp**

What to Expect

- Worship, Games, Activities, & FUN!
- Gym Activities (bring tennis shoes)
- ***On Saturday all campers will go on a fun offsite field trip (more details to come). The cost for this outing is included in the Winter Camp Registration. Campers are welcome to bring spending money for concessions. Make sure that campers bring a pair of tennis shoes and/or warm clothing to wear!***
