

Dear Families and Campers,

Welcome to Lincoln Park Baseball Academy's Baseball Camp at Latin! Baseball Camp runs June 17-21 (no camp on June 19), and meets daily from 9:00 AM-3:00 PM. The campers will meet in Latin's Upper School at 59 W. North Blvd. (located on the southeast corner of North Avenue and Clark Street). The instructors will meet the campers in the Upper School lobby (1/2 flight up the stairs beyond the reception desk) and will take them to the Lincoln Park baseball fields each day, weather permitting. If we have inclement weather during the week, camp will be held in Latin's Upper School.

All campers must check in with their coaches daily, and will be dismissed once signed out. If your camper has permission to self-dismiss, please email us with the written permission. If a camper will be absent from camp on any day, please email us at summer@latinschool.org or phone our office at 312.582.6080 to notify us of the absence.

Campers must bring a bag lunch each day. Please also include a refillable water bottle with the camper's name on it, and a healthy snack. Due to severe peanut and tree nut allergies, please do not pack any food items that contain peanuts, peanut products, or tree nuts in your child's lunch or snack.

Campers must bring a signed [LPBA Liability Form](#) to camp on the first day. Each day, campers must bring (or wear):

- *Hat
- *T-shirt
- *Baseball pants or shorts
- *Cleats AND gym shoes (if weather is bad, camp will be inside--no cleats are allowed inside our buildings)
- *Sunblock
- *Baseball glove. *Water bottle *Bat (if you have one)

LPBA will have some gloves and bats for campers to borrow.

Our Upper School will have the drop off and pick up areas marked by cones, and Latin traffic personnel will be available to assist. If, however, you want to come into the building even for a moment, you must park your car legally. No cars may be left unattended in the curb cut. The curb cut is a no parking zone, and vehicles parked in the curb cut may be ticketed and towed at the owner's expense. Latin's traffic personnel may clear the chute periodically and request that you circle the block, so arriving early for dismissal is not recommended. Your cooperation with this is greatly
