# Early RISErs Ages 3-4

#### Full-day: 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.: \$385 Half-day mornings: 8:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m.: \$225 Half-day afternoons: 12:00 p.m.-3:00 p.m.: \$225 \*\* Built in multi-week, early registration, and sibling discounts!

Spending the day away from home can be a big deal for three- and four-year-olds. Our caring, experienced, and engaged Early RISEr counselors lead campers in exciting and fun camp activities. Each week, they'll explore a different theme like To the Moon and Back, Super Hero Super You, or Creepy Crawly Critters.

Our campers also enjoy our community garden and weekly musical play that incorporates instruments, singing, dancing, and live storytelling with Lindsay Meehan founder of Music for Children. And in the heat of the summer, they'll get to cool off with water activities and in sprinklers on MB's campus.

Requirements: All children must be toilet-trained prior to attending camp (including rest time).

### Lower RISE Ages 5-7

Full-day: 8:30 a.m.–3:00 p.m.: \$400 Half-day mornings: 8:30 a.m.–12:30 p.m.: \$225 Half-day afternoons: 12:00-3:00 p.m.: \$225

With a 5:1 counselor-to-camper ratio, the Lower Camp staff personalizes every child's summer camp experience to be as fun and creative as possible! And with offerings that are just right for their age group, every camper can grow and explore in ways that develop their confidence and sense of self.

Explorations: build observation, imagination, and artistic skills

Weekly challenge: a variety of challenges, new every week. The campers will use their imagination, engineering skills, strength, and teamwork skills to meet a challenge presented to them at the beginning of each week. Examples are, building with the use of only simple machines, a Lego challenge, a pyramid challenge etc.

Activities: weekly choice to work on developing a specific skill– can be competing in games, cooking, learning to make friendship bracelets or playing frisbee

Optional: daily choice where campers engage in their favorite type of activities—from water slide, crafts, dance lessons, Legos or outdoor team games

Children must be entering Kindergarten to be eligible for Lower Camp.

# Sports Camps



## **Evening Soccer Clinic**

#### Grades 7-12 5:30 p.m. - 7 p.m. M-Thursday: \$200/session

This program is for players who wish to prepare for the fall season by refining their skills. Coach Vieira is eager to bring athletes into the twenty-first century using a unique combination of education and coaching. This program develops the knowledge and skills necessary to help players continue training on their own. This is a demanding camp program that will allow campers to work intensively on skills and that will help them grow technically, tactically, physically, and psychologically.

## Baseball

#### Grades 5-8 Full Day: 8:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.: \$350

Baseball camp will provide an engaging and insightful opportunity to hone your baseball skills. We will focus on the fundamentals of the game, including hitting, infield defense, outfield defense, and pitching. We will also take time to dive into intangible skills such as leadership, teamwork, baseball knowledge, and more. All of this will be featured in a fun and energizing environment led by Varsity Coach Kyle Warren along with well-respected coaches and current Moses Brown baseball players!

### Lacrosse

Grades 2-8 Full Day: 8:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.: \$475

Players will have fun learning to pass, shoot, and cradle the ball through tough defenders! They'll learn about every phase of the game in an environment that is challenging and encouraging, and which always insists on good sportsmanship. With a game every day, they'll get to try out what they've learned with their friends. The boy's and girl's camps run at the same time, focusing on their specific rules of the game (they do not play each other). Campers will also learn about wall-ball techniques and how to take care of their equipment.

Our coaching staff includes Moses Brown lacrosse alumni, top coaches in the high school and college community, college players, and special guest speakers. Our goal is to maintain a camper to staff ratio of 6:1.

# Field Hockey

#### Grades K-12 8:30am-12:00pm, \$295

Moses Brown's celebrated field hockey coach and Allegiance Field Hockey Co-founder, Leslie Caito-Jones, will guide beginners and advanced players to have fun and play their best. Girls entering grades K–12 can develop their understanding of the game, build their skills, and enjoy fun and fitness with their friends.

Sessions focus on ball control skills, elimination moves, passing and receiving, 1v1 defense, tactical concepts, and small game play. All skill sessions and games will be played on the turf field to ensure a smooth and fast playing surface. Focus will be placed on expanding leadership skills through hands-on activities and team-building exercises.

Girls will learn field hockey in a fun and supportive environment, develop their leadership abilities, and learn how to give their best for the good of the team.

### One on One Basketball

Ages 5-15 Full-day: 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.: \$276 Half-day: 8:30 a.m.-12:00 p.m. : \$156 Prorated for 4 days, no camp on June 19

One on One Basketball camps are highly structured and staffed with experienced coaches including Coach Frank Luca, and various high school and college coaches. Our camper to coach ratio will be about 9 to 1, which allows for plenty of individual instruction. Our goal is helping your children become better basketball players while having an enjoyable experience.

### Soccer

Ages 6-15: Full or Half-day Soccer Program Ages 4-5: Half-day only Munchkin Program

Full-day: 8:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.: \$345 Half-day and Munchkins: 8:30–12:00 p.m.: \$195

Moses Brown partners with Proactive Soccer to offer a challenging, fun environment in which players enhance their soccer skills. Coach Paul Janaway directs the Soccer Camp, which is a serious endeavor with coaches expecting full attention and effort. The camp is always a tremendous amount of fun. The program remains a favorite among parents and children because of Paul's inspirational, encouraging, and educational coaching style.

Players, grouped by age and skill, gain a better understanding of the game, sharpen skills, strengthen tactical awareness, and improve fitness.

Our Munchkin campers (ages 4-5) work on many soccer skills through mini activities. We then pull all of these skills together by the end of each week and showcase the development of the child.

### Squash

Ages 6-18 Half-day 8:30 a.m.- 12:00 p.m.: \$250

Our squash camp caters to everyone – from beginner to elite junior squash players. We believe in creating a fun and relaxed atmosphere which is key for students to have a positive experience, enjoy the process of learning and improving their squash alongside getting fitter, healthier, and making friends.

All sessions begin with a fun warm up including team games for movement & coordination, balance routines and major muscle activation. For the younger, less experienced players, emphasis will be on technique and tactical awareness via condition game. For the older, more experienced players, we will be building on the swing foundations with deeper strategic insight. This will be accomplished through targeted drilling and friendly, respectful competition. All sessions will have a fitness component.

# Volleyball Camp

Moses Brown School partners with Chess Master Connections (CMC) in offering week-long chess camps to beginning to advanced players, ages 5-14. The staff is comprised of World Champions, International Masters, and enthusiastic instructors.

The life skills of winning and losing well, creating a plan and following it, focusing on you and your opponent's actions, and the importance of creativity are all masterfully imparted throughout their instruction.

### Marvelous Discoveries Club!

Grades 1-5 Full-day: 8:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m.: \$360 Prorated for 4 days, no camp on June 19

Did you know that science is all around us? Science is an adventure in asking questions, making discoveries and sharing fascinating information!

When food is cooked, why do the windows get foggy at times? Why is my hand colder after I sanitize my hands? What is potential energy and where can I find it?

Campers will explore distinct and unique hands-on activities that engage them in a discovery of further knowledge in physics, chemistry, astronomy, earth science and biology. This camp will be the destination for enjoyment with and learning in science!

### Club Med

#### Grades 5-8 Full-day: 8:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.: \$450

Join us in June as we dive into the wonderful world of medical science and biotechnology! Have you ever been interested in dissecting a sheep brain or learning how DNA is used to solve a crime scene? If so, then this camp is for you! During this exciting week, students in grades 5-8 will learn about the human body and how it works. We will focus primarily on the cardiovascular and nervous systems. During these units, students will learn techniques for dissections and suturing. We will also do a deep dive into genetics and use MB Middle School's newest PCR (polymerase chain reaction) and gel electrophoresis technology. Students will be able to make billions of copies of DNA extracts to diagnose patients with a genetic disease and solve a crime scene using this state of the art technology! Students will also make important career connections and will have guest speakers that work in the fields that they're learning about in the lab and walk away with skills that they could use in a real world biotech lab!

### Snapology - Incredible Inventions Robotics

#### Grades 2-5 Full-day: 8:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.: \$450

Whoever said you couldn't solve the world's problems with LEGO® bricks? Learn a little about the process real inventors go through to create new inventions while you help design, build, and program robotic machines to solve problems. Your camper will learn the fundamentals of programming while navigating through programming software to make their inventions operate, how to correctly use and program motors, tilt sensors and motion sensors to allow their creations to move properly and complete challenges. They will also be able to experiment with various gears and pulleys to complete their exciting inventions. Each class, your child will be presented with a challenge to solve. They must brainstorm solutions with their group and build their robotic solution. Campers will discover there are many possible ways to solve a problem as they learn the importance of planning in the problem-solving process.

### Snapology - Responsive Robotics with Cubelets

#### Grades K-2 Full-day: 8:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m.: \$450

In this challenge-focused program, your student will begin to develop their computational thinking skills by playing with modular, robotic cubes known as Cubelets! Imagine this- every way your campers snaps the magnetic cubes together creates a unique robot, but what really matters is how they figure out the perfect robot recipe to solves a challenge. They will work in small teams to figure out how to create energy-efficient lighthouses, race bots, maze-solvers, goofy animals, and so much more!

## Strings

#### Grades 4-8 Tuesdays: 5:30-7:30 p.m.

Elementary and Middle School aged students with at least one year of school or private instruction are invited to participate in our Moses Brown Summer String Orchestras! This is a wonderful way to keep playing through the summer, solidify concepts students learned the past year with their teachers, and to play in an ensemble with other students! This is a once-a-week program that runs for 8 weeks on Tuesday evenings from 5:30-7:30pm (no class on July 9th) with a culminating concert on August 20th. To accommodate enrollment and varying ability levels, the time frames may be shortened to create separate ensembles, but will stay within the 5:30-7:30pm time frame. To ensure that your child has the best musical experience with us, families will be sent a form to complete regarding their current playing ability

# MB Summer Theatre Intensive (STI) Jr.

Grades 3-5 Full-day: 8:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m.: \$380 Prorated for 4 days, no camp on June 19

Calling all actors and theatre designers! This one-week theatre intensive taught by professional actors, designers and educators focuses on fun theatre games, acting exercises and collaboration! We will build community, exercise our imagination and empathy and participate in the craft of creation! Students will get a 360degree perspective on playmaking and teamwork. It's so fun, we don't even realize how much we are learning! No prior experience necessary - come join us in Moses Brown's Beautiful Woodman Center for STI Jr.!

### Studio Playground

Ages 8-12 Full-day: 8:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m. 3 weeks: \$1350

Join Studio Playground at Moses Brown School for our summer performance camp! Studio Playground teaches classes based in clown and physical acting. Students explore the benefits of laughter through movement, collaboration, and playful improvisation. # Extended Day

Morning drop-off available starting at 7:30 a.m. – \$48 weekly Afternoon care available until 5:30 p.m. – \$69 weekly Morning & Afternoon - \$110 weekly

Preregistration is required and fees will be billed through your on-line account. Extended day is a weekly service and we do not pro-rate for unused days including illness, absence, or change in plans. Because of planning and staffing complexities, we cannot refund for extended day services.

### <u>Lunch</u>

Full day campers should bring lunch from home or purchase our fresh, wholesome and delicious lunch option. Lunches are nut free and we offer limited vegetarian options. We do not pro-rate for unused days. (Early RISE does not participate in our lunch program) Weekly lunch option \$40 per week. Campers must pre-register for lunch during the registration process or email

mbplusoffice@mosesbrown.org within at least 5 days notice. All meals are prepared by Moses Brown's food service provider – Sage Dining Services.

MB Camps follows the Moses Brown "Nut Aware" Policy. This means that we will not at any time serve food with peanuts or tree nuts. With this in mind, we ask that our campers and staff do NOT PACK PEANUT BUTTER OR ANY NUT PRODUCTS in their lunches or snacks.



# **Cancellations and Fees**

### Cancellations

Our cancellation fees are based on expenses we incur to make and take reservations, purchase supplies based on our camp groups, receive and refund payments, and most importantly commitment to our wonderful counselors who are guaranteed employment. We review and update our staffing needs with each reservation received.

- If we are unable to run camp for any reason, we will issue a full refund.
- From January 1 May 25, 2024: a \$50 deposit will be retained to cover processing and administrative costs for EACH camp reservation canceled provided it is requested more than 14 days prior to the first day of the reservation.
- After May 25, 2024: a \$100 processing fee will be retained for EACH camp reservation canceled provided it is requested more than 14 days prior to the first day of the reservation. Each full or half-day session is considered a separate reservation.
- Regardless of when a reservation is made, no refunds will be granted for any camps canceled with less than 14 days prior to the first day of the reservation.
- No refunds for absences or inclement weather.
  We are not obligated to refund for illness or injury.
- Due to planning and staffing complexities, refunds are not available for lunch or extended day reservations, so please plan carefully.

### Fees

Camp fees are established for an entire camp week. The safety of our campers is our primary concern. Part of ensuring their safety is consistency in their attendance within the weeks they attend. Thus, we will not accept registrations for partial weeks and cannot allow any mixed full-day or half-day registrations within a camp in a given week. Please call with any questions regarding this policy, which applies to all camps. Tuition adjustments will not be allowed for any unattended camp days.

### Change Fee

A \$30 processing and administrative fee will be applied for EACH camp registration change made to the original registration provided it is requested more than 14 days prior to the first day of the reservation. Please note that should a change be necessary, it is to be made directly with Auxiliary Services at 401.831.7350 x150, and not with the camp directors or counselors. Changes made less than 14 days prior to the first day of the camp season are considered cancellations.

### **Return Check Fee**

\$30 will be applied for any checks returned by the bank.

### Late Pick Up Fee

\$15 per quarter hour fee will be applied for any camper not picked up within 15 minutes of camp dismissal or extended day hours.

# **Financial Aid**

Moses Brown offers a limited amount of assistance for RISE and Early RISERs camps for qualified families experiencing financial hardship and is awarded on a first-come, first-serve basis. Camp scholarships are based on space availability and completion of documentation as well as availability of funds for the program. If funds are awarded, all camps will require payment or a payment plan at time of registration. Please allow us 10 days to process your application.

# **Discounts**

Multi-Week Discounts: RISE and Early RISErs/Preschool camps only—built-in multi-week discounts are available starting at week 4. Our registration system will automatically calculate the discount at check out. Starting at week 4 the discount is \$15/week for full-day and \$5/week for half-day.

Early Bird Discount: RISE and Early RISErs/Preschool camps only; for campers with registrations received by April 6, 2024—\$10/week full-day, \$5/week half-day.

Sibling Discount: RISE and Early RISErs(preschool) camps only; for siblings attending the same weeks—\$10/week full-day or \$5/week half-day (does not apply to the first camper).
