Chess Camp will be in Friends Hall on the Moses Brown campus from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. for full-day campers and 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. **OR** 12 p.m. - 3p.m. for half-day campers. If someone other than the parent/ guardian will be picking up a camper, a note of authorization and photo ID must be given to the camp director. The schedule for each day of camp will differ slightly, and will include instruction, free play, history of chess, chess rules, problem solving, chess tactics, end games, blind fold exhibitions, chess and art, and much more.

Water, juice and individually wrapped snacks will be available throughout the day, however full-day campers should bring their own lunch and an extra drink. Campers will be assigned to groups including chess instructors.
