- ☐ **IF YOUR VOLUNTEER TAKES A DIFFERENT DOSAGE THAN WHAT'S PRINTED ON THE PRESCRIPTION LABEL, YOU MUST INCLUDE WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE PRESCRIBING DOCTOR—WITHOUT THIS, WE CANNOT LEGALLY ADMINISTER THE MEDICATION.**

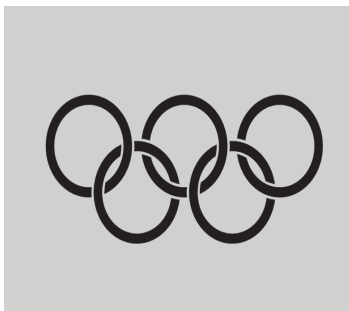

ARRIVAL & PICK UP

THE PRIMARY CARETAKER, WHETHER A LEGAL GUARDIAN, NURSING AIDE, OR OTHER DESIGNATED CAREGIVER, **MUST BE PRESENT AT DROP-OFF** AND IS **REQUIRED** TO MEET WITH THE CAMPER'S 1:1 BUDDY, CABIN LEADERS, AND THE CLINIC (IF MEDICATIONS ARE BEING DROPPED OFF.) THIS INDIVIDUAL **MUST** HAVE DETAILED KNOWLEDGE OF YOUR CAMPER'S DAILY CARE ROUTINES AND MEDICATION REGIMEN.

FOR THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF EACH CAMPER, WRITTEN NOTES OR SECOND-HAND INSTRUCTIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR THE CARETAKER'S PRESENCE AT DROP OFF.

IF A PRIMARY CARETAKER IS NOT PRESENT AT DROP-OFF, THE FAMILY WILL NOT HAVE MET THE EXPECTATIONS FOR A SAFE CHECK-IN. AS A RESULT, THE CAMPER MAY NOT BE ABLE TO REMAIN AT CAMP. REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN IF DROP-OFF EXPECTATIONS ARE NOT MET.

ILLNESS AND BEHAVIOR PICK-UP POLICIES

ILLNESS:

- IF YOUR CAMPER IS SHOWING SYMPTOMS OF AN ILLNESS, THEY WILL BE TAKEN TO THE CLINIC FOR MONITORING AND WILL BE ISOLATED FROM CAMP ACTIVITIES FOR A PERIOD OF 24 HOURS FOLLOWING THE LAST SIGN OF SYMPTOMS
- IF YOUR CAMPER HAS A FEVER, THEY WILL BE TAKEN TO THE CLINIC FOR MONITORING AND WILL BE ISOLATED FROM CAMP ACTIVITIES FOR A PERIOD OF 24 HOURS. THEY MAY RETURN TO CAMP ACTIVITIES FOLLOWING 24 HOURS BEING FEVER FREE, WITHOUT MEDICATION.
- IF THE FEVER PERSISTS FOR MORE THAN 24 HOURS, THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN WILL BE CALLED IMMEDIATELY AND WILL BE REQUIRED TO PICK UP YOUR CAMPER WITHIN 8 HOURS.
- PARTIAL REFUNDS MAY BE GIVEN IF AN EARLY DEPARTURE IS REQUIRED DUE TO ILLNESS.

BEHAVIOR:

CAMP BLESSING IS NOT EQUIPPED AS A MENTAL HEALTH OR CRISIS CENTER AND DO NOT HAVE THE TRAINED AND QUALIFIED STAFF TO SUPPORT SUCH NEEDS.

- ANY BEHAVIOR THAT IS A THREAT OF HARM TO SELF OR OTHERS WILL RESULT IN ISOLATION FROM CAMP ACTIVITIES AND AN IMMEDIATE CALL WILL BE MADE TO THEIR PARENT OR GUARDIAN AND ARE REQUIRED TO PICK UP THE CAMPER WITHIN 8 HOURS.
- IF THE PARENT / GUARDIAN REFUSES TO PICK UP THE CAMPER, CAMP BLESSING WILL CALL EMERGENCY SERVICES TO TRANSPORT THE CAMPER TO AN APPROPRIATE FACILITY WITH QUALIFIED PERSONNEL.
- REFUNDS WILL NOT BE GIVEN IF EARLY DEPARTURE IS A RESULT OF BEHAVIORAL ISSUES.
