## ADDITIONAL RECREATION, GRADE 3 & UP

**ADVANCE SIGN-UP IS RECOMMENDED TO RESERVE A SPACE.**

Minimum & maximum height & weight requirements apply to fit the safety harness on Leap of Faith, Giant Swing and Zip Line Adventures.

- **LEAP OF FAITH: No Additional Cost** — Climb the 33-ft pole, balance on the small platform at the top, then take the Leap of Faith by jumping into the air and floating safely to the ground.
- **GIANT SWING: \$6 per person** — Fly high above the game field!
- **Paintball (11:00 a.m. Meet at The Creekside Veranda): \$10 per person** — 1-hr play time. Includes equipment rental and 1 hopper of paint. Chest protectors/vests are available to rent for \$5. Extra paint is available for purchase: \$20 for 1 bag/500 rounds; \$35 for 1/2 box/1000 rounds, \$60 for 1 box/2000 rounds.
- **ZIP LINE ADVENTURES (1:00 p.m.): \$25 per person** — Soar like an eagle from peak to peak across the camp and back on the twin 800 foot zip lines!

## LAKE FISHING & FISHING TUTORIAL

**ONLY catch & release fishing FROM THE BANK is allowed.**

**THE FISHING TUTORIAL IS ONLY OFFERED DURING THE FIRST 20 MINUTES OF SESSIONS 1 AND 2.** Fishing equipment & bait

are not provided. However, worms are available for purchase and a limited number of fishing poles are available for rent at the Camp Store. Fish include small mouth bass, catfish and bluegill.


# HOMESCHOOL FAMILY DAY CAMP

## PRESCHOOL PLAY AREA

## WHAT TO BRING & WEAR

**CLIMBING TOWER & LEAP OF FAITH:** Closed-Toe Athletic Shoes are **REQUIRED**.

**HIKING & FISHING:** Boots or Closed-Toe Athletic Shoes are **RECOMMENDED**.

**PAINTBALL:** Boots or Closed-Toe Athletic Shoes, a Long-Sleeve Shirt/Jacket, Long Pants and Gloves are **RECOMMENDED**.

- A picnic lunch for your family to enjoy on the property — The Camp Store will be open for purchasing snacks and beverages from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- A blanket and/or tablecloth and folding recreational chairs are recommended
- Casual clothing and athletic shoes for recreational activities — See items required and recommended in the box above.
- Rain boots or river sandals for creek splashin’
- Towels and an extra change of clothes or shoes in case your child gets wet or muddy while in the creek or while playing
- Insect repellent especially for fishing on the lake bank and for paintball
- Sunscreen or rain gear — depending on the weather
- **IF FISHING or ATTENDING THE FISHING TUTORIAL:** Bring your own bait & tackle — Fishing equipment and bait are not provided. However, worms are available for purchase, and a limited number of fishing poles are available for rent, at the Camp Store. Fish include small mouth bass, catfish and bluegill.

### WHAT NOT TO BRING ANYTIME

Deer Run has a strict no alcohol policy.

*For everyone’s safety* — No firearms, weapons or fireworks can be brought onto the property.

### WHAT NOT TO WEAR ANYTIME

We request that clothing with offensive language or promoting persons, bands or products which are offensive not be worn while at Deer Run.

### SMOKING

Please smoke in designated smoking areas outside the buildings where smoking towers are provided. Smoking is NOT allowed in grassy or wooded areas including trails.

Because Deer Run is rural property, there are no nearby fire station or fire hydrants, so we ask that you be extremely cautious.

## FAQs

### **DO ADULTS NEED TO REGISTER AND PAY?**

Yes. This is a family event and adults are encouraged to participate in all activities with their children, not just watch. At least one adult must be on site and have an armband to participate.

You may make arrangements for a parent from another family to supervise your children, but a Responsibility Liability Release must be signed by you. This waiver can be filled out during online registration OR is available on the next page for printing, signing and bringing on the day of the event.

### **CAN I BRING SOMEONE ELSE'S CHILDREN?**

Yes, you can bring someone else's child(ren) as long as that child's parent has signed a Waiver of Liability Release. See the previous paragraph for details.

### **WHAT IS THE BEST AGE RANGE FOR CHILDREN?**

Programmed activities target children age 5 and up. However, a parent may assist younger children with crafts or other games. Additional adventure rec activities are available for grade 3 and up.

### **DO WE STAY TOGETHER AS A FAMILY?**

Most families stay together during the day. However, since there are many options to choose from, some families choose to split up so everyone can participate in the activities of their choice.

### **WHAT IF WE CANNOT STAY THE ENTIRE DAY?**

Stay as long as you can, but there is no reduced fee if you cannot stay all day.

### **WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS?**

Deer Run staff will watch the radar closely. If extreme weather is expected, a decision to reschedule the event may be necessary. If rescheduled, we will post a notice on [www.Facebook.com/DeerRunRetreat](http://www.Facebook.com/DeerRunRetreat) by 7 a.m. the day of the event.

Otherwise, this is a rain or shine event and will proceed as scheduled.

### **CAN WE PURCHASE LUNCH AT DEER RUN?**

Lunch is not available for purchase at this event. Bring a picnic lunch to enjoy on the property.

Deer Run's Camp Store is open to purchase snacks and beverages from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Prices vary depending upon selections and range in price from \$.50 to \$3.00 each for food or drink item.

### **IS DEER RUN AFFILIATED WITH A SPECIFIC DENOMINATION OR CHURCH?**

No, Deer Run is a nondenominational, 501(c)(3) nonprofit Christian ministry. Deer Run has a volunteer board of directors and is funded through user fees, individual donations and grants. Deer Run is not owned, governed or funded by a church or church organization.
