Check In

3:30-5:30 pm on Sunday, June 23, June 30 or July 7, depending on which camp you are attending. Please let us know if you will be arriving late. During check-in, any remaining financial transactions will be completed and each registered camper will be given a vinyl wristband to wear. *The Registration Fee of \$115/person applies to <u>all</u> campers ages 4 and over.*

Check Out

9:00 am Sunday, June 30, July 7 or July 14, depending on your week. We need the time between camps to clean and prepare for the next bunch, so please be respectful of our check out time. Thank you.

Meal Sign Up Form

Leoni Meadows Camp is known for its excellent food service. **Meals must be ordered by June 10.** Since we pre order our supplies, **meals ordered after June 10 will cost an additional \$1 per meal. Full-meal deals ordered after that date will be \$10.00 more.** The Country Fair and Rodeo Suppers on Wednesday and Thursday night are already included with your registration fee. Ice, Milk, and Bread are available for purchase while you're here. All meals are served for 1 hour. Menus and meal order forms will be emailed in the Spring.

Consent, Release & Assumption of Risk Agreement Form

We need everyone to fill out and sign the Family Camp Consent Form. Most do it during the sign-up process, but if you are bringing someone else's child with your family and need us to send you printed forms, give us a call and we're happy to mail them. Registered guests are covered with certain limitations by camp's accident insurance.

Quiet Time

Out of consideration for your neighbors, we ask that you observe our quiet time of 10:00 pm.

Pets

Remember, NO PETS are allowed at Family Camp so be sure to find a pet sitter before camp starts. We are sorry if this causes an inconvenience for you but we must enforce this policy for the comfort of our guests and the maintenance of the facility.

Firearms or Fireworks

Discharging of firearms or fireworks or their possession on the grounds is strictly prohibited by Leoni Meadows and El Dorado County. Plan to have your fireworks celebrations <u>before or after</u> you come.

Tobacco, Alcohol, & Drugs

Leoni Meadows is a smoke-free, alcohol-free, drug-free environment. Smoking and/or drinking of alcohol and/or taking of illegal drugs is not permitted on Leoni Meadows property or in any of the buildings.

<u>ATMs</u>

There are no ATMs available at Leoni Meadows Camp, but we do accept credit/debit cards for payments.

Camp Store

There is a fantastic selection of T-shirts, sweatshirts and gift items available! Also available in limited supply are useful items such as bug spray, band-aids, and batteries.

Cell Phones/Internet

We do not have reliable cell service at Leoni Meadows, but there are phones in the Leoni Lodge and Meadow View Inn lobbies available for your use. We do have FREE WI-FI in the Leoni Lodge. Just look for Guest. There is no password necessary to log on.

ATVs/VEHICLES

The personal use of ATVs is restricted to off-campus. For personal vehicles, please use designated parking only; and for pedestrian safety, please refrain from unnecessary vehicle travel while on campus.

What to Bring

The climate at Leoni Meadows is moderately warm during the day, but can get quite cool at night. Be sure to bring a jacket, sweater or sweatshirt. Campers should also bring along pool towels, closed-toe shoes and long pants (for riding horses and challenge course), modest swim suit, and good walking shoes. Feel free to bring your own bicycles (including helmets), roller blades, wagons, badminton, basketballs, etc., if you wish, or you may use some of our equipment.

- Cabins: You will need to bring all your own bedding, towels, supplies, cooking, cleaning, eating utensils, etc.
- Camp Sites: You will need to bring all your own bedding, towels, supplies, utensils, etc., as well as a camp stove. Most sites have access to power & water, but you may need to bring an extra long water hose or power cord. Campsites do not have fire pits, so plan to use your stove or BBQ.
- Lodge Rooms: All bedding and linens are provided for two queen beds, but please bring your own towels for the pool or pond and extra bedding for children sleeping on the floor.
