



2017 SUMMER CAMP CONFIRMATION

CHECK-IN

SUNDAY Check-In Time:

3 p.m. – 4:30 p.m. for all campers

WEDNESDAY Check-in Time:

If your child's camp begins on Wednesday, the check-in time will be from 3 p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

A Health Form and Waiver of Liability Form is required for all campers. If you have not already done so, please login to your account and complete the forms. These are located for each child individually under his/her "Forms" section. If you do not know your login information or would like to request a paper copy of the forms, please call the Trout Lake Camps office at 218.543.4565 – we are happy to help!

Camper Release:

For Primary, Primary Plus and Juniors Campers - On opening day you or the adult who brings your child is required to list anyone authorized to pick-up your child on closing day. These are the only individuals permitted to complete the checkout process (picture ID required) and pick-up your child. Please notify camp of any changes before Saturday. This is for your child's safety.

PACKING GUIDELINES FOR CAMP

Important guidelines as you pack for camp:

- Make your bags visually distinctive! Add something brightly colored to the outside of your bags. This makes it easier for you to spot them when you pick up your camper, and it prevents other people from taking your bags by mistake. Identification tags should have the camper's name, home address, parent cell phone number, and email.
- A "stuff" bag is recommended for your camper's pillow and sleeping bag.
- Place toiletries in a type of plastic bag or kit that makes it easy to travel to the showers and reduces the risk of spilling.
- Include an extra garbage bag for dirty or wet clothing.
- Remember to bring any medications your camper may need. They will have to check-in any medications with the camp nurse at registration.

Items to Leave at Home:

- Valuables
- Non-prescription or over-the-counter medications
- Cell phones
- Gaming devices, iPods, MP3 Players, etc.

CHECKOUT

FRIDAY or SATURDAY Checkout:

10 a.m. for all campers

All campers (including Timber Ridge) will be picked up from The Point. We invite all parents and campers to join us for the closing show, which begins at 10 a.m. Checkout will follow the closing show.

During the weeks of June 25-30 and August 20-26 there will be a closing show for only Timber Ridge campers in the Stoneridge Chapel. This will begin at 10 a.m. Checkout will follow the closing show.

WEDNESDAY Checkout:

If your child's camp ends on Wednesday, the check out time is at 10 a.m. (brief closing show).

Photos and DVDs:

If your child attends a shortened week of camp, photos and DVDs will be mailed to the primary contact address.

STORE DEPOSIT / SPENDING MONEY

Each camper will have an account that holds his or her spending money. Parents can monitor this account throughout the week and add spending money if desired. Log in and click on the Additional Options tab, then proceed to Camp Store.

Primary and Primary Plus:

All activities for Primary and Primary Plus camps are of no additional cost. This includes an arena horse ride.

Juniors:

While most of the activities for Juniors camps are of no additional cost, a few cost extra (Trail Rides \$12, Tubing, Water Skiing and Wakeboarding \$12).

Young Teens:

While most of the activities for Young Teens camps are of no additional cost, a few cost extra (Paintball \$12, Trail Rides \$12, Tubing, Water Skiing and Wakeboarding \$12).

All campers will also have many opportunities to visit the store, craft shack, Soda Fountain/The Barn and canteen (prices range from \$0.50-\$40). The amount of spending money brought will vary. Last year the "average" camper brought around \$50.00.
