

WELCOME TO SUMMER CAMP AT STUART 2023 !

The Stuart Faculty who teach in our Summer camps and I are very pleased to welcome you and your daughter and/or son to our camps. Here is some very important information:

REGISTRATION DEADLINE and policy for Medical information :

Registration closes at 9:00 am on *Thursday* prior to the first day of camp. A current immunization record must be uploaded to your account by NOON on that day in order for a camper to be cleared for attendance the following week. A camper with an incomplete account will not be able to attend on the first day.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We plan in advance for staff and program for each week so refunds will not be issued unless Stuart makes the decision to cancel a week of camp because of insufficient enrollment. Two weeks prior to the first day of camp Anne Pierpont, Director of Auxiliary Programs will notify parents if there is a *possibility* that we might cancel a particular week.

MEDICATION AT CAMP

If your child requires medication, the appropriate treatment plan must also be uploaded to our camp registration site. The medication and prescription must be delivered to Nurse Tine Boss on the first morning of camp, before the child may join the camp and must be picked up on Friday afternoon.

ARRIVAL/DROP-OFF:

On the first day of the week at 8:45 AM, please park in one of the lots in front of the school and enter through the front door near the flagpole.

PICK-UP

The Director of your child's program will sign her/him out at the front door each afternoon.
