This student is applying to participate in the Children's Hospital Colorado Winter Burn Camp from February 6-10, 2023. The mission of the Children's Hospital Colorado Burn Camps Program is to improve the lives of burn-injured children and their families through the use of an enriched curriculum providing physical and social challenges in a safe environment with other burn survivors. We encourage learning and the practice of life skills which help our campers and their families face their fears, meet new people and identify their own personal strengths.

As a part of the application, participants must identify a school and homework plan with teachers for the missed time prior to being accepted into the program.

Traumatic experiences related to burn injury can derail developmental progress and change family dynamics. This rehabilitative medical specialty camp allows children the opportunity to re-process those traumatic experiences and lay down new pathways toward healing.

This program may overlap with the last days of the semester. The structure and intentional curriculum help students redefine what is possible and what they are capable of in their own lives. Please excuse this student from their missed school days with confidence that our program adheres to a curriculum that requires high-level processing and responsibility of all participants.
