Summer Camp at Canterbury is rapidly approaching, and we are excited that you will be joining us! We are ready for all that accompanies each session: learning new things, friendships, discovery, and fun. A few things you need to know before you get here:

Daily Schedule - Knowlton Campus* - 990 62nd Ave NE 33702

- **8:30 a.m. - 8:55 a.m.:** Full Day/AM Camps Drop Off– campers may be dropped off no earlier than 8:30 a.m.; campers are held before camp in Knowlton Cafe (*see drop off procedures below*)
- **9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.:** AM Camps
- **12:00 p.m.:** AM Pick Up (*see pick up procedures below*) - AM campers must be picked up by 12:15 p.m.
- **12:00 p.m - 12:50 p.m.:** Lunch is **not** provided. Supervised lunch in the Knowlton Cafe is held only for campers in full-day (or 2 half-day camps).
- **12:45 p.m - 1:00 p.m.:** PM Camps Drop Off –campers may be dropped off no earlier than 12:45 p.m.; campers are held before camp in Knowlton Cafe (*see drop off procedures below*)
- **1:00 p.m - 4:00 p.m.:** PM Camps
- **4:00 p.m.:** PM/Full Day Camps Pick-Up – campers must be picked up by 4:15 p.m. **
Hooray for PreK is held on the Hough Campus

DROP OFF PROCEDURES: (8:30 a.m. - 8:55 a.m., 12:45 p.m. – 1:00 p.m.)

- All traffic on campus is one-way at all times. Please enter the entrance off of 62nd Avenue (Knowlton Campus: 990 62nd Ave NE)
- **Please do not drop off your child before 8:30 a.m.** (or 12:45 p.m. for PM camps); there will be no adult assigned to supervise them until 8:30 a.m. (or 12:45 p.m.)
- Please follow the traffic flow outlined on the attached map to drop off and pick up your camper at the front steps
- Please do not get out of your car in the carline – there will be adults and volunteers to escort and direct your camper.
- You will be given a brightly-colored name placard to put on your dashboard for easy identification at pickup times.

Lunch Procedures: (12:00 p.m. - 12:50 p.m.)

- Campers who are staying for a full day of camp(s) are welcome to stay for lunch held in the Knowlton Cafe. Campers in one (1) half-day camp must be picked up and dropped off according to the daily schedule.
- Lunch is NOT provided.
- Canterbury Student Volunteers will supervise the campers during lunch.

PICK UP PROCEDURES: (12:00 - 12:15 p.m., 4:00 p.m. - 4:15 p.m.)

- Please follow the traffic flow outlined on the attached map for drop off and pick up.
- At Pick Up, vehicles will line up in the drop off zone and camp staff will call camper names to meet their cars.
- Please place your camper name placard in your car window to help expedite the pick up process.
- *Please note that After Care is not available. All campers must be picked up by 12:15 p.m. or 4:15 p.m.

What To Pack - All Items Must Be Labeled with the Camper's Name

- Reusable water bottle (filled)
- Snacks (Canterbury will not be providing snacks)
- Lunch with ice-pack (if applicable)
- Closed-toed shoes (campers should *not* wear flip flops)
- Sunscreen (please apply sunscreen before drop off each day)
- Change of clothing + hat (for outdoor activities)
- A positive attitude

What NOT to Pack

- Cell phones - your camper will have access to a school phone if they need to reach you
- Any other electronic devices - unless specifically requested by the instructor
- Distracting toys or anything that will be missed if lost
