Camp Trained Adults:

- 1. Individual Format: Girl(s) must be accompanied by a registered female parent/guardian with an appropriate volunteer security status, and with the appropriate level of camp training. Because girls are supervised by their parent/guardian, the adult is not required to be First Aid/CPR/AED certified.
- 2. Troop Format: Each Girl Scout Troop must have at least one registered Camp Trained Adult who has completed the appropriate level of camp training and one registered First Aid/CPR/AED Trained Adult. It is strongly encouraged that this not be the same individual. Each Camp and First Aid/CPR/AED certified adult must have the appropriate volunteer security status.
- 3. Non-Troop Format: The number of camp-trained adults must be one for each group of up to 10 Daisies or Brownies and one for each group of up to 35 Juniors, Cadettes, Seniors or Ambassadors. For all program grade levels, they must be camping within an area of approximately 150 square yards. These events must have a Health Supervisor who is a registered female Girl Scout adult with level I First Aid/CPR/AED certification from an approved provider unless the number of girls is more than 200. If the number of girls is more than 200, the Health Supervisor must have a certification that is level II. Both the individuals certified for Camping and First Aid/CPR/AED cannot additionally fill any other event staff positions including but not limited to Event Coordinator, Camp Certification, Health Supervisor or Lifeguard. Each Camp and First Aid/CPR/AED certified adult must have the appropriate volunteer security status.
