COVID-19

Wearing a mask will not be required for 2022 but left up to the parent's/guardian/s discretion. We will use prevention strategies recommended by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the American Camp Association (ACA).

It is important to note that our practices and policies may change and if they do, we'll be updating the information listed on our <u>COVID-19</u> web page to adapt to current conditions.

Packing Lists

Just prior to camp arrival, please check to see that you have the most recent packing list (your packing list may have been updated since you first reviewed and/or printed it.)

Registration/Check-In

Check-in is from 3-5. When you arrive at camp, there will be a luggage drop off. Once that is done, we will have you park starting at the playground area pass the ballfield. The line will start under the porch and up the ramp to the upper room. From there, if your camper has medication you will go to the nurse and they will gather any medication and directions from the parents. After this check-in process;

you can help take their luggage up the hill to their assigned cabin. *If all your paperwork is complete the process will go faster.

Photos/Video

Wesley Woods will have photos taken daily and uploaded to our Wesley Woods Camp and Retreat Facebook page. There is a waiver to be signed by the parents giving us permission to take your campers photo/video and use it; or you can also let us know if you would prefer your campers photo/video to not be taken.

Mail and Email

The mail is delivered every day. Once our office receives it; we will pass it along to your cabin counselor to distribute it. The mailing address is:
