Come join this NEW CLUB combining electrical engineering, robotics and coding. In this pilot program, children will develop analytical, problem-solving and critical thinking skills as we construct simple, but clever robots from scratch. We will work in teams to design and assemble robotic creatures that avoid obstacles and react to their environment using circuits, motors, batteries, and switches. This club will include lots of hands-on hardware building activities, including wire-cutting, wire-stripping, heat shrinking, soldering and hot glue assembly. Students will combine creativity and logic into their problem solving, building on the some of the same skills developed in the MFS Lower School Coding program. **\*\*Children will be carefully supervised during use of the glue gun. Only the adults will be soldering while children will learn by observation.**
