



## Arrival and Departure Information

### **DRIVING to and from camp?**

Please carpool, if at all possible!

#### **Check In on Sunday at 3:30 p.m.**

- ✓ Park in the designated parking spaces near the entrance to camp. Drop off camper luggage at designated location for staff members to deliver to the campers' wakeyas.
- ✓ Follow the signs to the check-in area, where campers will meet their counselors.
- ✓ Medications must be kept separate from the luggage and be ready to turn in to a camp staff member. All medications must be in their original containers with dosage instructions clearly marked.
- ✓ In order to minimize the possibility of homesickness for your camper and others, please say good-bye after check-in. A full afternoon of fun is scheduled!

#### **Pick-Up from Camp on Saturday at 9:30 a.m.**

- ✓ Arrive at Camp Westminister on Higgins Lake at 9:30 a.m. to check out your camper. Please park in the lot near the entrance to camp, and walk to the checkout table in main camp.
- ✓ Your camper will be released **only** to the persons listed by you as authorized to pick up your child. Identification (*e.g.* driver's license) **MUST** be presented at check-out. Campers will not be released until the identity of the person picking up the camper has been verified.
- ✓ Please plan to stay for a brief closing circle where your campers will relate highlights from their week.

### **TAKING THE BUS to and from camp?**

#### **Check-In for Bus on Sunday at 12:30 p.m. at Westminister Church of Detroit**

- ✓ Check-in is at 12:30 p.m. Enter the church via the east entrance off Hubbell Ave. Plan to stay with your camper until he or she boards the bus.
- ✓ Medications must be kept separate from the luggage and be ready to turn in to a camp staff member. All medications must be in their original containers with dosage instructions clearly marked.
- ✓ Camp staff members will ride the bus to camp, and will assist campers with move-in to the wakeyas.
- ✓ Campers riding the bus must: remain seated at all times with hands and arms inside the vehicle, fasten seatbelts, and refrain from all activities distracting to the driver.

#### **Pick-Up from Bus on Saturday at 3:00 p.m. at Westminister Church of Detroit**

- ✓ Arrive at Westminister Church promptly at 3:00 p.m. to pick up your camper. Please use the east entrance off Hubbell Ave.
- ✓ Your camper will be released **only** to the persons listed by you as authorized to pick up your child. Identification (*e.g.* driver's license) **MUST** be presented at check-out. Campers will not be released until the identity of the person picking up the camper has been verified.

*In the event of an emergency that affects campers' pick-up and/or drop-off time or location, camp staff will directly contact the parent/guardians of campers via phone.*
