Getting Your Camper To and From Camp Westminster Please remember

- Please submit health documents (physician form, health card, etc.) ahead of time.
- Pack medications in their original containers with dosage instructions. Have these ready to turn in to camp health staff.
- Make sure all the people who might pick up your camper are listed as authorized in the registration process. For help with this, email marna@campwestminster.com.
- Anyone picking up a camper must present a government-issued photo ID.

Arriving at Camp Westminster on Sunday

Driving to Camp Westminster 116 Westminster Dr, Roscommon, MI 48072 Check-in starts at 3:30 p.m.

Drop-off will occur drive-through style; families will stay in cars and proceed through registration stations.

- After turning onto camp, families will stay in cars and proceed down the road, going through the health officer station, camp store station, and final check-in registration station.
- Families can get out of vehicles at final check-in to help unload and say goodbyes for the week.
- There will be time for families to see camp at pickup on Friday.
