

Sae Jong Camp Code of Conduct

As a Camper I will...

- Recognize I am a part of the Sae Jong Camp community. I will respect the environment, peers, staff and myself.
- Treat people the way I would like to be treated.
- Cooperate with camp staff and follow their instructions. This includes rules and regulations put forth by each staff member.
- Help keep my cabin and the surrounding environment clean and put all litter in the trashcans.
- Have good hygiene by having regular showers, brushing my teeth and changing my clothes regularly.
- Stay with my counselors, unless I have special permission not to be with them.
- Participate in my classes, elective and group activities, unless I have special permission to do otherwise.
- Be courteous to fellow campers, staff members and Camp Westminster staff.
- Talk to a staff member if I feel unsafe.
- Have lots of FUN and a GREAT time.

I will not...

- Bully, or put down other campers or staff verbally or by non-verbal means.
- Trespass, steal, vandalize or graffiti any property.
- Enter the cabins of others unless a member of that cabin has invited me.
- Leave my cabin at night (when I should be sleeping) unless going to the Greenie or under direct staff supervision.
- Deliberately hurt anybody's feelings. Including pulling pranks on others, or touching them or gesturing in a manner which could cause someone to feel offended, unsafe or that could lead to injury or property damage.
- Transport, sell, purchase or consume tobacco products, alcohol or illegal substances of any kind while at Sae Jong Camp.
- Use foul or abusive language (this includes profanity and explicit language).
- Use cell phones and other mobile communication devices during Camp, unless authorized by a staff member. I understand electronics, such as iPads, iPods, video games, computers, etc., are also prohibited. (Any such item brought to camp will be taken up and returned at the end of Camp. Sae Jong Camp is not responsible for theft or damage to any camper personal property.)

I understand that if I violate this code of conduct, the following could happen:

- I may have a meeting with my counselor, program director or the camp director.
- A staff member might call my parents to discuss my behavior.
- I may be asked to carry out a suitable consequence decided by the staff. (An example of a consequence is writing an apology letter.)
- If my behavior is hurtful to myself, others or camp property, I may be sent home prior to the end of camp and forfeit any fees paid.
