

### At Camp Drop-off and Pick-up

Your camper's check-in and pick-up times are determined by which cabin they are assigned to. This information will be emailed out 3-5 days before arrival at camp, but drop off times are assigned between 2 p.m. and 330 p.m. Our Friday pick up times are typically between 130 p.m. and 230 p.m. **NOTE**: If you are dropping off RAD campers and REG campers, it is ok to drop off REG campers at the earlier RAD camper drop-off time.

**Approved Camper Pick-ups (at camp or from bus):** When being picked up from Big Lake or from the bus, campers will only be released to persons listed on their **Approved Pick-up List**. Any individual picking up a camper will be required to show ID before the camper can be released into their care. This check-out process is for your camper's safety. It is your responsibility to update this list.

Persons added to a camper's Emergency Contact list are not authorized to pick-up unless you add them to both lists. The primary contact must also add the other parent, in a two-parent household, for both parents to be authorized to pick up a camper.

#### **Bus Transportation Guidelines**

- **Camper Drop-off**: Since drop-off is during lunch time, it is best if you either feed your camper before drop-off or send a lunch with them.
- **Bus Arrangements:** Adding bus transportation after 12pm on the Wednesday before camp starts will incur a \$25 administrative fee. Calling/emailing after this deadline does not guarantee space availability.
- **Camper Supervision at Bus Stops:** Please remain with your child/children until they are safely checked onto the bus. Once children are on the bus, Big Lake staff will take over supervision.
- **Confirming Transportation Arrangements:** While your child is at camp, we may call to confirm travel home plans—especially if your camper is unclear as to their own arrangements. Campers are always more comfortable at camp if they know prior to camp what travel arrangements have been made.
- **Transportation Changes:** Our policy is for campers to leave by the means indicated on your online account. Any changes to bus transportation after camper check-in (includes switching pick-up locations and adding and/or removing bus transportation) will incur a \$25 administrative fee upon notification of the change.
- **Delayed Buses:** It is always our goal to have the buses leave on time. The pick-up times listed are *only estimates* of when we think the buses will arrive. We will text the Primary Contact if there will be significant changes in arrival times. Please be available on Fridays for a phone call/text.

- If you have not checked in your camper by 1215 p.m., we will try to reach out to the Primary Contact listed on your registration account. The bus will leave as soon as our medical team has all medications and health forms organized, which is usually by 1 p.m.
- Camper Health Forms must be completed online by the Thursday before your camper is to be dropped off for the bus as we print them for the medical station check-in. We would recommend taking screenshots of each completed page of the health form
- **Camper medications must be in their original packaging**. Please don't just bring the medication in a baggie. Our medical staff needs to see the dosage and dosing instructions written by the doctor specific to your camper.

# **Directions to Camp**

To reach Big Lake Youth Camp, turn off of Highway 20 at the Big Lake/Hoodoo Ski Area sign and follow the road signs to the camp located on the eastern shore of Big Lake, about 4 miles from Highway 20.

Big Lake Youth Camp is a 2.5-3 hour drive from the Portland, OR area. Many parents go on to the nearby town of Sisters after dropping off or picking up campers.
