### COVID-19 Requirements Checklist

***\*\*Please Read Fully\*\****

#### **Actions prior to Check-In:**

- ✓ **Get Tested OR Get Vaccinated:** It is required that each camper meets one of the following (A OR B) to be permitted to check-in for camp session.
  - A. Complete a rapid COVID-19 test with negative results within 3 days prior to Check-in date.
  - B. Get Fully Vaccinated for COVID-19. Fully vaccinated status as outlined by the CDC at start of Camp.
- ✓ **Monitor Temperature and Symptoms:** Monitor your camper for symptoms of COVID-19 for the week before your camper's scheduled session.
- ✓ **Stay Vigilant / Educate Camper:** Reduce risk of exposure by limiting your camper's interactions with larger groups outside of your household two weeks prior to their camp session.

#### **Items required on day of Check-in:**

- ✓ **Confirmation of Negative COVID-19 Test OR Proof of Vaccination.**
  - o Test results must not be generated more than 3 days prior to check-in date*
  - o Note: We will ask that you confirm either a negative test result or full vaccination to check in, but we will not keep these records*
- ✓ **Completed COVID-19 Pre-Camp Symptoms Survey**
- ✓ **Signed COVID-19 Legal Waiver**
- ✓ **Standard Summer Camper Documents:**
  - o (Camper Confidential, Release Form, & Medical History Form)*

#### **Additional Reminders:**

- ✓ Please make special notice and don't forget the Camper Packing List.
- ✓ Remember, campers are only permitted to have one legal guardian present at Check-In.
- ✓ Please do not unpack or bring any luggage out of your vehicle until **after** you have completed the Check-in process and your camper has been given their cabin information.
