Clothing

Closed-toed, closed-heeled shoes (1)

- 2nd pair if you can in case they get wet from the rain

Warm sweater and/or sweatshirt (1)

Pants & shorts (1-2 pair each)

T-shirts (2) *one from the state you call home*

Long sleeved shirt (1)

Underwear (3)

Socks (3)

Hat with brim (1)

Bandana (optional)

Knit hat (1)

Rain Gear (waterproof jacket or poncho)

Warm pajamas (1)

Warm coat (1)

Camp Gear

Trefoil Ranch – Horseback Riding:

- Riding boots with a 1/2 inch heel
- Camp has boots you can borrow as well.
- Must have long pants.

Cloud Rim Waterfront:

- Swimming suit (optional as you can wear your regular clothes while boating)
- Towel for the waterfront
- USCG approved lifejacket (optional)
- Water Shoes (for water activities)
Need closed-toed, closed-heeled

Sleeping bag (20 degrees or cooler)

Pillow

Warm blanket or fleece liner

24-32 ounce durable water bottle

Mess Kit (cup, bowl, and spoon)

Sunglasses

Backpack or daypack

Flashlight with extra batteries

Towel (1-2 depending on activities)

Shower shoes (flip flops, water shoes)

*SWAPS – only up to 10 per person
