



# CAMP CHICKAGAMI

## COVID-19 Plan and Protocol for Guests As of March 9, 2020

**Share this document with all members of your group. Everyone is expected to review and adhere to the following protocols for the health and safety of all.**

We are looking forward to hosting your group this season at Camp Chickagami. Your health and safety and that of our greater community is our priority. We are taking great care to be proactive about the emerging community health concern of COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus).

1. If you have any respiratory symptoms or fever (above 100 degrees F), or live in the same household as someone who has displayed those symptoms within the last 14 days, you must stay home. If you begin to show symptoms while you are at Camp Chickagami, we will ask you to go home.
2. We require the same of the Camp Chickagami staff. If a staff member is sick or lives in the same household as someone who is sick, they will not come to work.
3. We will follow the industry standards for sanitation to clean and disinfect lodges, meeting spaces and restrooms throughout your stay and between guest groups.

This includes:

- i. Using a disinfectant solution approved by the Center for Disease Control (D) for COVID-19 to wipe down commonly used surfaces: light switches, tables, and counters, doorknobs, and frames sink, faucets and handles, and toilet bowls.
  - ii. Laundering linens in hot water and drying completely
4. All staff and guests must wash their hands frequently and thoroughly with soap and water for 20 seconds, avoid face touching, and cough or sneeze into an elbow or tissue and then throw the tissue away.
  5. We have extra supplies of hand sanitizer available throughout the lodges, and we remind everyone that hand sanitizer is not a replacement for washing your hands.

6. We are monitoring the situation daily and will adapt our procedures as necessary to comply with local, state, or national recommendations from the County Health Department and the CDC.
7. We are committed to working with each group and your unique needs as it relates to your contract. Please know that we care about your group and the way we support each other providing fair and just solutions.
8. Camp Chickagami will reevaluate our policies and reserves the right to make changes as new information is available from the CDC or County Health Department.
