MONEY

CAMP STORE MONEY: Campers deposit spending money during check-in on Monday or on the camp's online registration system. This money goes in their *Camp Store Account* and is drawn from like a debit card when campers shop at the camp store. T-shirts, sweatshirts, novelties, snacks, pop, and personal items are available. Usually \$20-\$35 is an adequate amount.

Pick Up 4:00-4:30 pm at Playground

Plan to pick up your child **NO LATER THAN 4:30 pm**

Exceptions must be **prearranged and approved** by the Camp Director.

Any child not picked up by 4:30pm will be charged \$1 a minute.

Failure to contact the camp or pick up your child by 5:00pm will result in a call to Child Protective Services as an abandoned child.

Please use modesty and discretion in your choice of clothing & swimwear (no bikinis or male speedos), no bare midriff, no exposed cleavage or under garments. Straps on shirts must be 2 fingers wide and inseams at least 3 inches.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- Knives
- Electronic Devices (i.e. cell phone, electronic games, CD player, IPod, etc.)
- Pop, Candy, Gum
- Pets
- Illegal substances (alcohol, recreational drugs, tobacco)
- Weapons of any kind

TRANSPORTATION

You are responsible for your camper's transportation to and from camp. A map is enclosed.

If you are not picking up your own child, please make sure the transporting adult's name is on the camper release form.

HEALTH CARE/FIRST AID

A Camp Nurse is on duty at all times providing first aid, medication administration, and lots of TLC.

Over-the-counter medicines will be administered as needed based on the Camp Physician's standing orders and the nurse's assessment of the situation.

If your child requires medications between the hours of 8:30am and 4:30pm, we have a nurse onsite to administer medication. Please bring the medication daily and turn into the camp nurse. Medication must be in a small Ziploc bag or labeled container.

Cascade Camp Cedarbrook carries secondary medical insurance for injuries occurring at camp, after your primary insurance coverage has been used.

You will be contacted by the Camp Nurse if your child becomes ill/injured to the point where outside medical intervention appears necessary.
