#### Requirements and Things to Know from Sound View Camp

- Only enter the water at designated times and if a Sound View lifeguard is on duty. Beachcombing is okay.
- Boating Lifejackets must be worn at all times. Children must be accompanied by an adult at the waterfront at all times.
- Lounge furniture and beds may not be moved.
- No food or beverages in sleeping areas, meeting rooms only.
- Tacks or pins are allowed on bulletin boards only. Do not use tape anywhere.
- Quiet hours are 10:00PM to 8:00AM.
- Meals are served at specified times with family style dining. There is usually fruit, cereal, and simple sandwich fixings in the dining hall at most hours for hungry kids. Listen for the bell.
