## WHAT CAN WE DO OUTSIDE OF OUR FACILITY?

- Sound View has miles of beautiful hiking trails; see the map on the reverse side for more details
- Our breathtaking waterfront and pier are available to all groups.
  Located at the waterfront are horse shoe pits, a sand volleyball court, teather ball, a firepit, and if you arrange a lifeguard - canoes, kayaks, peddle boats and swimming. There is also nearly half a mile of beach and driftwood to comb.
- The athletic field, outdoor basketball court, activity building, tree house, picnic shelters and campfire sites around camp are all available on a first-come, first-served basis.

- The activity building includes equipment for pickle ball, volleyball, basketball and soccer, and can be set up for barbeques... all under cover in case it rains! - Sound View has an 18 hole frisbee golf course; it begins and ends in front of the Dining Hall, and travels in a loop around camp. Maps are available.

- Cell phones often find reception on the athletic field, or at the waterfront.
