CAMP ROTATIONS

PSR Camp divides the activity schedule into four, 1-hour class periods.

DISCOVERY, JUNIOR, & TWEEN ROTATIONS

Monday - Thursday Rotation #1: 10:30 - 11:30 am Rotation #2: 11:40 - 12:40 pm Rotation #3: 3:00 - 4:00 pm Rotation #4: 4:10 - 5:10 pm

Friday AM Selects: 10:30 - 12:40 pm (If available) PM Selects: 3:00 - 5:10 pm (Splashing Eagle Waterpark 2:00 - 5:10 pm. This option is not available 4th of July weekend.)

Children who choose 'Camp Rotations' as their primary activity will rotate through the activities listed at the bottom of the page during those four periods.

PSR Camp creates a schedule of rotations, to ensure that children get to try as many different activities as possible. All of the activities are offered at a difficulty that is appropriate to the age of the participant in order to provide enjoyment, challenges, and opportunities to be successful for all of our campers. Some cabin groups may get to try an activity more than once and have the opportunity to build a little more skill in that area.

Some activities have skill checks/tests that your camper will have to complete before being allowed to participate. Most children over age seven are able to pass these checks. Campers who are unable to pass a skills test will be assigned to another rotation unless they decide otherwise.

Camp rotations includes the following PSR Camp activities: archery, arts & crafts, climbing wall, drama games, field games, go-kart rides, hiking, nature, obstacle course, sports, & swimming.
