SOCCER CAMP REFUND POLICY:

- Withdrawal three weeks before the camp start date: If payment is more than the \$50 non-refundable deposit, the refund will be less than the amount of the deposit.
- No refund granted if withdrawal is within 2 weeks of camp.
- Special consideration will be given if withdrawal is for medical reasons.

CAMPER EXPECTATIONS AND INFORMATION:

These rules and regulations ensure that all campers have a positive, uplifting experience throughout the week. Many of these rules are for your safety, while others help create a welcoming environment for campers, coaches, and everyone sharing the campus this week.



- Demonstrate excellence in everything you do. Give your best during the few days you are here.
- Find ways to encourage and motivate fellow campers whenever possible.
- We have a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for bullying to ensure every camper's safety. We will not accept behaviors towards other campers that could be considered harassment, intimidation, threats, or demeaning. Any camper involved in such behavior will be dismissed from camp without a refund.
- No swearing, smoking, gambling, drinking, drugs, or indecent photos. Any such violations will be grounds for dismissal from camp without a refund.
- Modest attire is required; a shirt must be worn at all training sessions.
- Cell phones are not allowed during training sessions or formal camp gatherings unless a coach gives permission. Phones can be used in dorms and during mealtimes.
- All injuries must be reported to the Athletic Trainer when they occur. Keep up with necessary pre- and post-play treatments. The Athletic Trainers have many athletes to look after, so be diligent!
- Follow the Daily Schedule. Always be in the proper place. Be early!
- Be aware of roll-call times. You are responsible for being in the correct place with your assigned counselor.
- You must not leave campus unless approved by the Camp Director. If campers are authorized to leave early during the camp day, a parent must sign them out.
- Stay with your assigned counselor during free time. Campers are not permitted to be without counselor supervision for the duration of camp. Campers must stay with a counselor when transitioning between different campus areas.
- No camper is allowed to go back to the dorm or cafeteria without special permission from a coach.
- Campers are NOT allowed in ANY building except your dorm, the campus center, the athletic fields, KPAC, and the Nielsen Athletic Center unless instructed otherwise by the Camp Director.
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- Leave all areas, like the cafeteria, dorms, and athletic fields, cleaner and better than how we found them.
- Respect others' property. Vandalism or theft will result in immediate dismissal without a refund. Damage to University property will be charged to the camper and their parents or guardians.
- Please keep the dorms tidy and use the garbage cans on each floor.
- Never enter another camper's room without their explicit permission.
- Directors and floor counselors can inspect your room without prior notice.
- Be aware of lights-out times; these will be enforced throughout the week.
