Our older campers have been building shelters, learning first aid basics, using compasses, whittling, creating water filtration systems, and enjoying s'mores!



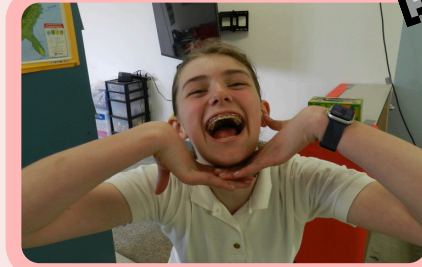
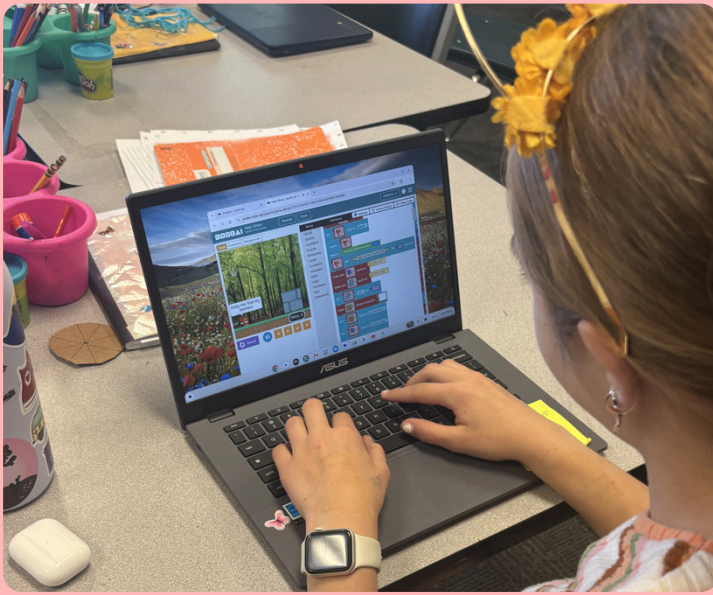
OUTDOOR SKILLS



Campers also enjoyed a visit from Alaska Dive Search and Rescue and Recovery, where they learned about water safety and heard real rescue stories from team members.



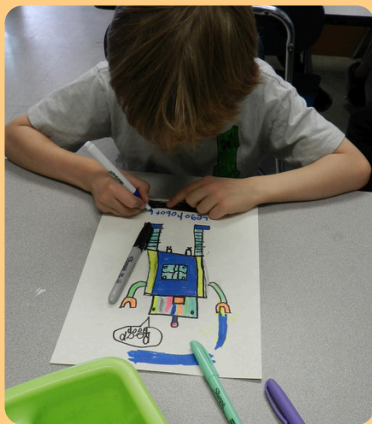
GIRLS WHO CODE



Our middle school group spent the week learning the basics of coding, deciphering messages, and using their skills, created their very own video games. On the last day they presented their creations to other campers!

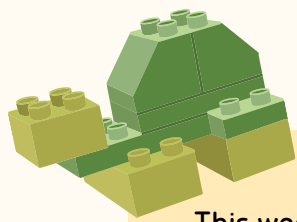


CREATIVE ARTS



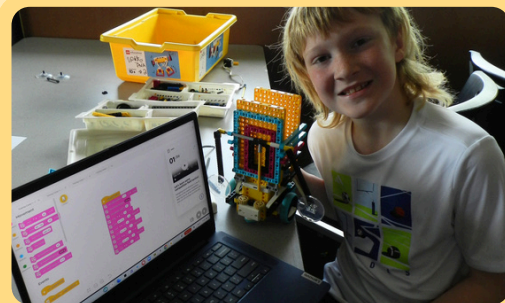
