Legenda Apie Geležinj Vilką / The Legend of the Iron Wolf (1990)

Exactly 700 years ago, Grand Duke Gediminas (Vytas Bazikas) was leader of Lithuania among relentless Crusaders attacks. His legendary dream of a howling iron wolf led to the founding of the capital city Vilnius. Directed by Neringa's dearly departed Antanas Kulbis, the movie was filmed on site at Camp Neringa and features several members of our community.

Motherland / Gimtinė (2019)

Shortly after the fall of the USSR, 12-year-old Kovas (Matas Metlevski) travels to his mother Viktorija's (Severija Janušauskaite) homeland for the first time. It's been 20 years since she escaped Soviet-Occupied Lithuania and has now returned to reclaim her beloved family estate. Viewers will enjoy a pre-recorded greeting from director and Neringa alumni Tomas Vengris.

Land of Songs / Dainava (2016)

In a region of Lithuania known as the Land of Songs (Dainava), five grandmothers may be the last voices of their village Puvočiai's ancient folk singing tradition. A moving documentary from Lithuanian-American Aldona Watts, we will follow the screening with our own song session to keep the tradition alive at Neringa.

Thug Rose: Mixed Martial Artist (2022)

The inspiring journey of professional MMA fighter and two-time world champion Rose Namajunas. Described by Draugas News as "the ultimate sports psychology film," veteran Lithuanian-American filmmaker Marius Markevičius (The Other Dream Team), the film documents her life journey and her singular ability to mesh physicality, artistry and Catholic faith. This screening will take place at the historic and beautiful Latchis Theater in downtown Brattleboro.

The Invisible Front (2014)

This is the story of one of the twentieth century's most significant anti-soviet resistance movements, told through the words and experiences of one of its leaders, Juozas Lukša (voiced by Andrius Mamontovas) and his fellow Forest Brothers. Director Vincas Sruoginis will be with us at Neringa for a Q&A session following the film.

Keliones Namo / Back to the Dreamland (2019)

Many Lithuanians who emigrated to the US after 1945 imagined their homeland to be a dreamland, where their culture and tradition were lovingly cultivated. So they experienced huge culture shock when the first visits "home" in the 1950s took them to a communist country. The spirited reminiscences are well illustrated with a variety of historical film footage, private family photographs, Super 8 film, and videos.
