What do I need to know about picking my camper up at Camp Lutherhoma when the session is over?

Camp Closing Programs begin at 2:30pm in the Outdoor Chapel on Friday. Please understand that your campers and their counselors are finishing camp activities until then. If you arrive early please do not disturb the cabin group activities. Thank you!

- 1. When you arrive park along the edge of the sports field.
- 2. Go to the Outdoor Chapel- follow the green and blue camp flags.
- 3. Report to the Check Out table near the bell tower at the Outdoor Chapel. At the check-out table you will <u>verify</u> that you are the person designated to pick up your camper (*present valid ID*), get the cabin release form, and pick up any unused medication or other items.
- 4. The closing program in the Outdoor Chapel starts at 2:30pm and should last between 45 minutes to an hour. If you are unable to attend the closing program meet us at the check out table at the Deck to pick up your camper release slip and camper medications at 3:30pm.
- 5. <u>Campers are released immediately following the closing program on the Deck.</u> Present the release form to the cabin counselor to claim your camper. The Camp Store will also be open for purchases.
- 6. Camper luggage will be placed in a shaded area near the parking area. Be sure to <u>double check that your camper has all personal belongings.</u> Call the camp office at 918-458-0704 if you discover any items that were left behind. Lost & Found items are given to charity in the fall.

If you aren't the adult picking up your camper,

please give this information to the adult you have designated on the release form.

Keeping in touch with your camper

Keeping in touch with your child is important. They love to get mail and encouraging notes from family and friends. Please help avoid homesickness by writing encouraging notes, keeping the conversation focused on their camp experiences, and not writing too many notes. The easiest way to send a note is through your online account. To Email your child:

- 1. Go to www.lutherhoma.com then click "Account Login" to log into your Camp Lutherhoma Account.
- 2. Click on the envelope icon in the top right corner—this is the Message Center.
- 3. Click "Email a Camper" and fill out the fields.

Emails are printed and delivered Monday through Friday.

Additionally, you can see photos of your child throughout the week by scanning the QR code.

You will also get an email with the link to the photo website. Usually the first photos of the week will be posted by Monday night. You can view, download, and purchase prints of photos of your camper.
