



Things to bring to Stony Lake:

Forms:

- For the smoothest check-in experience on your child's day of arrival to camp, filling out the forms as instructed through your online registration login is the most efficient solution. Please complete your child's forms prior to 1 week from their date of arrival.

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Items

- Additional Spending Money – this can be deposited online prior to check in, or at check in via credit card or bank account. (for camp store, pictures)*
- Medications – to be left with camp nurse **
- Clothes for one week – be prepared for warm & cold
 - Long sleeve shirts, t-shirts, long pants (**required** for low and high ropes), shorts, sweatshirt, socks, underwear, sunglasses, hats, raingear, pajamas
- Shoes
 - Closed toed shoes (**required** for low and high ropes), flipflops/sandals for beach and shower
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen, Bug spray
- Pillow and Sleeping bag or bedding for twin sized bed
- Towels – for shower and for beach
- Toiletries – soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, comb/brush, washcloth
- Reusable water bottle (available for purchase in camp store)
- Swimsuit
- Bible/pencil/paper
- Camera
- Stationery/stamps to write letters to mail from camp (camp does not have stamps for sale)
- Positive mental attitude

****SPENDING MONEY:** Sweatshirts, t-shirts, and souvenirs will be available along with some snack items at the camp store. All money will be collected at check-in and purchases will be deducted from banked funds. Unspent cash will be returned prior to checkout; online money will be dealt with in the way you specified during registration (refund or donation). A typical amount is approximately \$30.00.

***MEDICATIONS** must come to camp in their original containers! Medications will be collected by the Health Officer, documented, and made available as needed. All medications will be returned at the end of the week.

Things NOT to bring to Stony Lake:

- Food – personal snacks are not permitted unless prior conversations have taken place about allergies or other food related needs.
- Cell phones, music playing devices, video games or other electronics.
- Expensive watches, jewelry, etc.

It is assumed that campers will not bring tobacco, alcohol, illegal drugs, fireworks, firearms, or other weapons.
