



Horsemanship Lessons Information

Thank you for registering your child/children for our Horsemanship Lessons Program. Below is some important information for you and your child.

Parent Notes:

- Please arrive **15** minutes early to prepare for the lesson. (Please see directions below)
- Please dress your camper in weather-appropriate clothing. It is frequently cooler here at camp.
- Long pants and sturdy, closed-toe shoes are required; boots are preferred.
- Please send your student with a water bottle.
- Please keep all pets at home.
- Young children must be under adult supervision. We ask that parents and spectators please honor the barn's rules. Do not enter the arena or horse areas at any time. Please respect the instructor and students, and do not talk to your child while they are in class. It is the instructor's responsibility to keep your child safe, and it is disruptive to have side chatter and comments, however helpful you may think they are.
- Please also respect the campgrounds while waiting for your child. Camp activities are not open for families not participating with a staff. Families waiting may play on the swings at upper camp or walk around that area, but please do not enter the hay barn, go into pastures, or access other camp activities.
- Helmets are provided, or you can wear your ASTM-certified riding helmet.
- If you have an emergency and will be either late or unable to bring your child to Horsemanship Lessons, please use this phone number: 360.977.2922. (Please only use this number for emergencies.)

Due to our Summer Camp programs, *Horsemanship Lessons* are only offered during the school year. Winter Break and Spring Break are aligned with the Battle Ground Public School schedule and will also be off.

Horsemanship Lesson Breaks

Payment: The Horsemanship Lesson Program registration is set up in seasons. (Fall, Winter, Spring). During registration, you will pay the first month in full. Subsequent payments will be automatically billed, as shown below.

If you decide that your child/children will no longer be attending the Horsemanship Lessons program, you must email (registrations@royalridges.org) or call the office (360.686.3737) by the **1st** of the month, or your card will be automatically billed for the next month.

Your child will be automatically enrolled in the next term unless we hear otherwise from you.
