

# **Recreational Vaulting Lessons Information**

Thank you for registering your child/children for our Recreational Vaulting Lessons Program. Below is some important information for you and your child.

#### **Recreational Vaulting Lessons**

Wednesdays 4:00 - 6:00 pm

## **Parent Notes:**

- Please arrive 10 minutes early to prepare for the lesson. (Please see directions below.)
- Please send your student with a water bottle, soft, closed-toe shoes (no boots), and long comfortable pants.
- Helmets are NOT worn during this activity as it is against the vaulting standards due to the moves and activities involved. Vaulters are taught safe falls, and the footing in the arena is softer to provide softer landings.
- Please keep all pets at home.
- Young children not enrolled in a class must be under adult supervision. We ask that parents and spectators please honor the rules of the barn and that they do not enter the arena or horse areas at any time. Please respect the instructor and students and do not talk to your child while they are in class. It is the responsibility of the instructor to keep your child safe, and it is disruptive to have side chatter and comments, however helpful you may think them.
- Please also be respectful of the camp grounds while waiting for your child. Camp activities are not open for families that are not participating with a staff. Families that are waiting may play on the swings at upper camp or walk around that area, but please do not enter the hay barn, go into pastures, or access other camp activities.

Due to our Summer Camp programs, Recreational Vaulting Lessons are only offered during the school year. Winter Break and Spring Break are aligned with the Battle Ground Public School schedule and will also be off.

#### **Recreational Vaulting Lesson Breaks**

Thanksgiving Break: November 21-25, 2022

Winter Break: December 19-30, 2022

Spring Break: April 3-7, 2022

**Payment:** The Recreational Vaulting Lesson Program registration is set up for **35** weeks. During registration, you will set up your payments to be automatically billed on the **15th** of each month (December will be billed on the 7th).

If you decide that your child/children will no longer be attending the Recreational Vaulting Lessons program, you must email (<u>registrations@royalridges.org</u>) or call the office (360.686.3737) by the **1st** of the month, or your credit card will be automatically billed for the next month.
