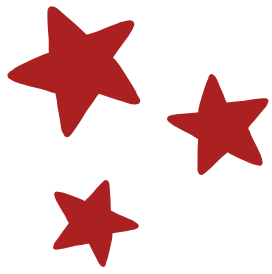


Elisabeth is from Houston, Tx, and is a Cowpoke!
