

## Welcome to all our first-time campers!



The Parent Handbook is your go-to source for all camp related info but we've gathered a few highlights here for your first day:

- **Drop off:** Begins at 8:15 am. Follow the drop off-line into our traffic circle and a staff member will help your camper out of your car. We ask that all parents stay in their vehicle during drop off and pick up. If you or your camper needs some extra time or support, we ask that you pull up to the First Day Camper parking spots on the right just past the traffic circle and a staff member will be happy to assist you.
- **Swim:** Every day campers will have a swim lesson with our Water Wonders Swim School staff followed by free swim time. On your camper's first day of camp, our swim staff will evaluate their swim ability to determine their swim level. Read in the Parent Handbook all about our swim levels. Lifeguards are always on duty during the camp day. If your child is especially anxious about swimming, please let us know.
- **Schedule:** Your child's day will be full of activities – most of them outdoors! Read in the Parent Handbook all about our daily programming. Please dress your child for the weather and to be comfortable playing and getting messy!
- **Pick up:** At the end of the day, our counselors will bring your camper to your car. If your child needs help buckling-up, please pull ahead to the designated area. Your child will be given 2 car signs with their name/camp group. When dropping off and picking up, please be sure to have this visible on your dashboard.



### Tips for a successful camp day:

- Pack a reusable water bottle (label with their LAST NAME)
- Have your camper wear shoes they can put on independently
- Pack lots of snacks – Campers get hungry!
- Apply sunscreen before they arrive. We will re-apply sunscreen mid-day
- **LABEL EVERYTHING** your camper brings to camp. Seriously – everything!
- **Check the handbook for what else to pack your camper each day!**
