

Welcome First Time Campers!

This newsletter contains all the information to help you find your way on the first day!

Drop Off & Pick Up



Drop Off: 8:15am / Pick Up: 4:30pm

Follow the drop off line into our traffic circle. Stay on the shoulder of the road to allow other traffic to get by. Follow this procedure for both drop off and pick up!

- Drop off begins at 8:15am
- Parents stay in their car during drop off and pick up. Counselors will get your child out of the car and to their group.
- **Camper car signs**- your child will be given 2 car signs. Please have 1 visible on your dashboard for drop off & pick up to help our carline move smoother.
- **Need extra time or support?** Let the counselor know at drop off, then pull forward to our "First Day Camper" sign and a staff member will be over to assist you. If your child needs help buckling at pick-up, Pull forward to our "buckle up" designated area.
- **Pick up 4:30-** A counselor will bring your child to the car.

- **Swim lesson**- Everyday for 30 mins. followed by 15 mins. of open swim time
- **Swim level**- determined on their 1st lesson
- **Life guards on duty**- at ALL times
- Please let us know if your child has any fears about swimming

What To Pack



- Reusable water bottle *LABELED*
- Lunch and 2 snacks (remind your camper they have 2 snack times)
- Extra set of clothes/socks (to change if they get wet or dirt)
- Towel & bathing suit (*goggles are optional but can not have the nose coverage*)

****Leave ALL personal items at home!**

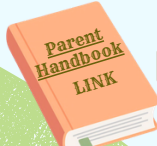
Camp Attire

Your child's day will be full of activities, most of them outdoors! Please dress your child in weather appropriate and comfortable clothing to move around and get messy!
Campers must arrive with sunscreen applied- we will reapply in the afternoon!

- **Shoes**- closed toe, able to take on and off independently (e.g., Crocs, Keens, etc.)
- **Clothing**- Pack extra layers for our cold mornings. Clothes WILL get dirty!
- **Bathing suit**- Please make sure it is camp appropriate and comfortable to move around in.
- **LIT/CIT's**- Don't forget to wear your specific shirt daily!
