



What is the Camp Show Caregiver Program?

As part of the Camp Show caregiver program, we will introduce you to eSCCIP (pronounced E-Skip). eSCCIP is an online program for caregivers of children diagnosed with cancer. It helps families learn new ways to cope with their child's cancer.

eSCCIP offers interactive activities as well as videos of other families who have experienced childhood cancer.

eSCCIP is comprised of three sessions:



Session 1:
Adversity-Belief-Consequence Model



Session 2:
Footsteps to Reframing



Session 3:
Family Survival Map

You will be asked to complete the online program on your own. Then, you will meet twice in a virtual group with other caregivers of children with cancer attending the Camp Show Weekend. You will get to share your experiences with others, and group leaders will guide conversations about what you learned in the online program.
