Camp Travel Form

Regardless of your method of travel, we ask that you complete the **April Camp Travel Form,** in UltraCamp, at your earliest convenience. This allows us time to adequately prepare for your arrival and departure shuttle.

Driving

If you are driving, plan to arrive no earlier than 5 P.M. Central Standard Time. When you arrive, park in a parking stall, even if you are just dropping off a camper, to avoid interfering with shuttles, moving equipment, and school operations.

Flying

Anyone flying must arrive at **Chicago O'Hare (ORD)**, then take the **Coach/Van Galder** bus to <u>Rockford, IL at 7559 Walton Street</u>. Chicago O'Hare Airport (ORD) is the only airport option to access the bus to Rockford, IL.

We will pick you up from the Van Galder bus stop and transport you to the camp. The Phantom Regiment shuttle will run continuously starting at 4:30 P.M. Friday, until all are picked up. Camp check-in is 5 P.M. to 7 P.M.. The bus ride from O'Hare to Rockford will be approximately 1-1/2 hours. The shuttle from the Coach/Van Galder bus stop to Auburn High School is approximately 25 minutes.

ARRIVAL ON FRIDAY: Try to schedule a flight that lands by 12 P.M. on Friday.

DEPARTURE ON SUNDAY: Your flight home should depart from the airport after 6 P.M. on Sunday. We will shuttle you back to the same Van Galder bus stop and then you'll ride the bus back to O'Hare. Early flights will cause you to miss most of, if not the entire day.

Instructions for after you land at O'Hare:

- Retrieve your checked luggage
- Go to the Multi-Modal/Rental Car Facility at 10255 W. Zemke Boulevard.
- Purchase ticket at the Van Galder desk to
 DESTINATION ZONE: 7559 Walton St- Van Galder Terminal Rockford, IL.

Additional Information for Coach/Van Galder Bus

- It is recommended you download the Coach USA app for the easiest access to real-time updates. You may also access information on the website at <u>coachusa.com</u>.
- Tickets can be purchased online or through the app ahead of time.
- Be sure to purchase a round-trip ticket.
- Ticket prices are currently \$48.00 (as of 10/23), but are subject to change.

Unaccompanied Minors

Coach/Van Galder has an unaccompanied minor policy. To avoid travel disruption, be sure to carry a signed permission slip onto the bus. The unaccompanied minor policy is as follows:

Minors under age 17 are allowed to ride under the following conditions:

- The parent must be present to purchase the ticket
- Emergency contact information must be provided
- The name and phone number of the person meeting the child must be provided to the driver
- If no one is there to meet the child, the authorities will be contacted.
- Those who are 17 and older may be asked to provide identification. If no identification is available, the driver has the right to refuse transportation.

This form must be carried onto the bus while traveling on Van Galder to and from the camp. Do not leave this in your luggage, as the driver may request to see it.

Area around the Van Galder bus stop



The red pin is the Van Galder bus stop. It is located within a fair walking distance from retail and restaurants should you arrive early and need anything while you wait; however, the area is not very pedestrian-friendly, so it is advisable to take care of those needs while in Chicago. In Rockford, there is a Walmart for general merchandise needs. Nearby restaurants include Steak & Shake, Burger King, Starbucks, Dunkin, McDonald's, Denny's, Texas Roadhouse, and Machine Shed.

Accommodations

You will receive an audition shirt upon your arrival to the first camp you attend. If you attend more than one, please remember to pack your shirt. You will write your name on the front of your shirt. If you really want to keep this shirt clean, or if you lose your audition shirt, a plain white tee shirt with your name is acceptable as well.
