

Camp Attitude Buddy Packing List

- □ Water Bottle
- □ Flashlight
- Bible / Notebook / Pen
- □ Spending Money for Smiley Shack Amount Varies, \$25+
- Wristwatch- NO smart watches! Charging options are not available in the buddy tents!
- D Pillow / Sleeping Bag / Extra Blanket
- Minimum of 2 Towels / Showering and for Lake Day/Water Fun
- □ Fanny Pack (if desired/needed)
- □ Sunglasses
- □ Toiletries, Sunscreen
- Prescription Medications Prescription meds are required by Oregon state law to be turned into the camp nurse, which will occur during check in. Rescue meds will remain with buddies.
- □ Hat/Visor/Beanie
- Tennis Shoes / Closed toe shoes are required for time at the horses!
- □ Water Shoes for Lake Day
 - Swimming and beach area is made up of small pebbles!
- □ Flip Flops for Showering
- □ Undergarments
- Jacket / Sweatshirt
- Previous Yellow Buddy Shirts (good condition and free of writing). Please write your name on the tag/inside collar, if faded.
- □ 1-3 Extra Shirts (no crop tops)
- □ Shorts (minimum 3.5" inseam)
- D Pants / Sweats
- □ Swimsuit: Required for Water Fun and Lake Day

Gals: Modest, one piece swimwear is requested, two pieces will need to be covered with an appropriate t-shirt Guys: Modest, loose fitting swim trunks are requested, guys are required to wear a t-shirt or tank with their swim trunks, no Speedos/form fitting swimwear

Optional

- D Personal Air Mattress/Sleeping Pad.
- We can't guarantee a mattress pad if you don't want to use the cot.
- □ Art notebook/coloring book/basic art supplies.
 - Buddies often draw/color with their assigned camper.
- □ Ear plugs (if you are light sleeper).
- U.S. Coastguard Approved Life Jacket (for Lake Day).
- Snacks (to be consumed in the buddy area only). NO nuts Week 1! Buddies may bring snacks, but are not allowed to share with their camper, due to safety concerns. The buddy tents can get hot and items like chocolate, gummy candy, etc. often melt.

Buddies Attending Adult Mini Session 3A and/or 3B ONLY

Swimsuit (even though there will be no lake day, your adult camper might participate in water activities hosted at camp).

Gals: Modest, prom style dresses are welcome for "Night to Smile Dance". Please refrain from bringing tight fitting, mini-skirt, or high slit dresses. The gals on the CORE Team and Gal Buddies will be assisting gal campers with hair, make up and nails.

Guys: Ties, bowties, suspenders, dress shirts, jackets, slacks, top hat, etc for "Night to Smile Dance".
