



Important Information for Camp Attitude Servants

Servant Team

Servant Team members will serve in various roles, including the kitchen. Volunteers aged 16+ may take on more detailed kitchen responsibilities.

Housing

Servants will coordinate accommodations with camp staff. Options include servant cottages or yurts, subject to availability. If unavailable, servants must bring a tent, RV, or trailer.

Food

Special diet options are available for medical needs (e.g., gluten-free, dairy-free). The camp is peanut- and nut-free during Week 1.

Weather

Daily temps range from 70°–90°, with nights averaging 45°–55°. Rain is possible. Dress in layers and check the 10-day forecast for Sweet Home, OR.

Activities

Servant Team members help encourage campers to participate in daily activities, such as arts, crafts, fishing, horseback riding, adaptive sports, and table games.

Water Play

Lake Day: Includes boating, tubing, and kayaking (priority given to campers).

Campus Water Play: Includes slides, splash pads, and sprinklers.

- Bring a swimsuit.
 - U.S. Coast Guard-approved life jackets are required for certain activities. Children under 13 must wear a life jacket in swim areas.

Servant Shirts

Servants receive one teal or gray shirt at check-in. Shirts must be worn at all times, except during water activities.

Showering

Servants shower at the main bathhouse. Camper families have priority. Portable toilets and handwashing stations are available.
