General Information

- Arrival time between 2 P.M. and 4 P.M. on the arrival day at camp
- Pickup time between 10 A.M. and 11 A.M. on the last day at camp
- With the current state of the mail service, we have been receiving mail much later than expected. It is currently recommended that you drop off your mail at camp when you drop off your camper.
- For any equipment that is listed as required which you do not have access to, Camp Hemlock may be able to provide borrowed equipment. To reserve this equipment, please reach out to us at info@camphemlock.org as soon as possible, as we do not have an unlimited amount of gear available. We will do our best to meet any needs requested in a timely manner though.
- To help your camper with a smooth transition to camp life, we kindly ask that you <u>abstain from calling your child while at camp</u> via the camp phone.
 Additionally, we will not be allowing your child to call home (barring extenuating circumstances). This helps to prevent homesickness and invites your child to focus on their surroundings.
- There are <u>no washing machines available</u> for use to wash clothing, so please pack accordingly so that your camper is not wearing the same pair of clothes all week.
- Camp Hemlock has a fully stocked nurse's station, so please <u>do not bring any</u>
 <u>basic over-the-counter medications</u> such as tylenol, ibuprofen, tums, isopropyl
 alcohol, hydrogen peroxide, etc. However, any specialty or daily-use
 medications such as allergy or melatonin should be brought.
- Anything sent with your camper is <u>subject to the great outdoors</u> and the treatment of your camper. Thus, do not send any clothing, shoes, outerwear, or gear that you would not like to return in the same condition.
- Please <u>leave the following items at home</u>: phone, hand-held electronic games, alcohol, tobacco, wallets, money, and knives.
- The camp store is open daily for campers. There are several souvenir items along with candy and beverages. \$10-30 is enough money. You were given the opportunity during online registration to put store money on your child's account. You can send your child with additional funds.
