

What to Bring to Camp...

2024 Theme – ‘Journey through the Stars ~ honoring those who are infinity and beyond’

Camp attire should be comfortable, casual and durable as well as appropriate for working around children. Old clothes are sometimes the best clothes for camp! Typical August weather is warm during the day and warm/cool in the evening. Being the Great Northwest, expect some rain!

Please mark all of your clothing, personal items, musical instruments and luggage with your name.

Clothing (please keep it MODEST)

Bug Juice (insect repellent)

Flashlight and Batteries
Musical Instruments
Money

Cabin Decorations –
Hats (the funkier the better)

Camera – you will be asked to NOT use your cell phone as a camera

Medications and Special Foods

Medications (prescriptions or “over the counter”) **will NOT be allowed in camper cabins.** Exceptions may be medications for asthma or allergies where there is the possibility of life threatening situations. In these cases, the medication shall be in the controlled possession of the staff person at all times. Staff sleeping in STAFF ONLY quarters may keep their own medication. Please mark all medication with your name.

There are vegetarian and gluten free options at camp, but plan to bring foods for any other special dietary needs.

A staff refrigerator will be available if you bring special foods.

PLEASE do not bring weapons, large amounts of cash, valuable jewelry and other valuable personal items. Camp Journey is not responsible for loss or damage of your personal property.
