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Camp Planning Countdown

1 Month Prior to Camp: Night Camp Staff Will Contact You

- You can expect an email from the Night Camp leadership team that will contain your camp details.
- Make sure to respond with any **food allergies, cultural animal restrictions or special needs for your family.**

2 Weeks Prior to Camp: Final Numbers Due, Review Handouts with Adult Participants

- Make any changes needed in participants attending camp in [Ultracamp](#).
- This is your last opportunity to:
 - Cancel your reservation without a cancellation fee.
 - Change your participant numbers.
 - Report any food restrictions.

The Week of Your Camp: Confirmation Email and Final Details

- You can expect a final check-in email from the Night Camp leadership team. They will review the details of your camp and answer any other questions you may have.
- Check the weather for the night of your camp and pack accordingly, we are a rain or shine event.
- On the date of your Night Camp, be excited and ready to have some fun at the Phoenix Zoo!

Day of Your Camp: Phoenix Zoo Waivers and Camp Phone

- Plan to arrive at the Phoenix Zoo early to unload and meet at the designated Zoo gate.
 - Overnight guests will meet Night Camp staff at 5:45 p.m. to set up tents.
 - Twilight (evening only) guests will meet Night Camp staff at 6:15 p.m.,
- **Required Form:** [Night Camp Waivers](#). Most participants will have completed the forms in the Phoenix Zoo's Ultracamp portal. However, if you filled out a physical copy, bring the signed forms with you on the evening of your camp to be turned in or email them prior to camp at camps@phoenixzoo.org.
- Running late or have a last-minute question? We are often away from our desks, contact the Night Camp staff phone at 602.274.2253 (only monitored on camp evenings).

Participant Confirmation, Payment, and Cancellation Policy

Participant Confirmation:

- Participant numbers can be adjusted higher or lower as needed, up to **two weeks (14 days) prior to the camp date**.
- You will be charged for the number of confirmed participants at two weeks. **No refunds for no shows.**
- **All campers and parents are required to stay for the full duration of the camp. No late arrivals or leaving early.**
- This program requires that you have at least one chaperone for every five campers.
- This program is capped at a maximum of 60 people total.

Payment:

- Payment must be made in full at the time of registration. Check, credit card and PO are all accepted forms of payment. Cash is not accepted. Tickets are subject to a processing fee of \$4.95 per transaction.
- All participants must be paid in advance before arriving to the Phoenix Zoo. Payments cannot be made during the Night Camp program.
 - Payments can be made through the [Ultracamp](#) registration portal.
 - The Contact Center is available for questions about navigating payment through Ultracamp during open admission hours at 602.286.3800 (press zero to reach the operator). Please check the website for current times on the [Visit the Phoenix Zoo](#) page.
- On your check or purchase order, please indicate the name of your group, order number and your Night Camp date. If you are using a PO, we will bill you after your visit.
 - Purchase orders may be emailed to reservations@phoenixzoo.org or mailed to the Phoenix Zoo Contact Center at 455 N. Galvin Pkwy. Phoenix, AZ 85008.
- If you are paying by check, please use only *one* check to pay for the total cost of the camp. Multiple checks will *not* be accepted.

Cancellation Policy:

- **If payment covering the full balance of the order is not received by end of day two weeks (14 days) prior to the camp date, the reservation will be cancelled and a cancellation notice via email will be sent to the booking contact**
- Camp cancellations made 21 days or more prior to the camp date will not be charged a cancellation fee.
 - Camp cancellations made 7-20 days prior to the camp date will be charged a 25% cancellation fee.
 - Camp cancellations made less than seven days prior to the camp date will be charged a 50% cancellation fee.
 - Processing fees are not refundable.



Dear Night Camp parents and guardians,

Here at the Phoenix Zoo, we strive to create an exciting, once-in-a-lifetime experience for your family! We hope you see this as a special opportunity to connect with the children in your group and experience the Zoo through their eyes. The more involved and present you are with your young campers, the more enjoyable the experience will be for them and for you.

Keep in mind that you will be walking, standing and sitting on the floor with the children for most of the evening hours.

Adults are responsible for managing the behavior of their group to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants.

Our camp expectations are:

1. Show respect to everyone (including animals, plants and each other).
2. Always stay with the group or designated camp area.
3. Follow all Zoo safety policies.
4. Keep flashlights, money, cameras or other electronics (including cell phones) in bags/gear
5. Have fun!

NOTE: *The Phoenix Zoo hosts a variety of events/programs and it is possible that your Night Camp may not be the only experience happening on Zoo grounds or in the surrounding area. While we do our best to keep interruptions to a minimum, your group may be aware that other events/programs are going on during your Night Camp (i.e. you may hear music, cheering crowds or briefly see guests from other events).*

NIGHT CAMP ITINERARY

5:30 p.m. – Overnight Families Arrive at the Zoo

- Unload your belongings.
- **5:45 p.m.** Meet instructors at designated location.
- Carry your belongings to camp sleeping site.
- Set up your tents.

6 p.m. – Twilight (evening only) Families Arrive

- **6:15 p.m.** Meet instructors at designated location.
- Walk to camp area and expectations.

6:30 p.m. – Pizza Dinner and Water Bottles

- Souvenir water bottles are provided for each camp participant. Water and lemonade available.

7 p.m. – As a Group

- Guided night hike.
- Presentations with Animal Ambassadors.

8:10 p.m. Snack:

- Provided kid-friendly snack.
- *Prior to camp, inform Night Camp staff if you or your camper(s) have any food allergies*

8:30 p.m. – Free-flow Activity Stations

- Art.
- Games.
- Learning activities.

Goodnight: Around 9:15 p.m.

- Twilight guests escorted to the exit.
- Overnight expectations.
- **Lights out:** Determined by parents/guardians.

Wake-Up: between 6: – 6:30 a.m.

Continental Breakfast:

- Brief morning time to freshen up.
- Pack up your belongings and take down tents.
- 7 a.m. – A light breakfast with coffee for adults.

Morning Activities:

- Move gear closer to the Zoo's main exit.
- Morning hike on Zoo grounds.
- **Leaving early is not permitted.**

Night Camp Ends: 9 a.m.

- Night Camp participants may enjoy the Zoo for the rest of the day at no extra charge (only for overnight participants).
- Other guests who wish to join, must pay regular entrance fees and enter during normal Zoo operating hours.

Phoenix Zoo Night Camp Policies

- All participants (campers, parents and chaperones) are expected to stay with the group at all times.
- All participants are expected to stay for the duration of the program. No late arrivals or early departures.
- Smoking is prohibited on Zoo grounds and in surrounding areas of Papago Park according to City of Phoenix law. Guests will not be permitted to leave Zoo grounds to smoke during the duration of the Night Camp program.
- Alcohol is not permitted at Night Camp. Anyone suspected of being under the influence will be escorted off Zoo grounds.

A Note about Flashlights and Cellphones

- Flashlights are not allowed on hikes and activities around the Zoo, but can be used at the campsite after the nighttime portion of the program is over.
- We ask that ALL participants (adults included) keep cellphones out of sight throughout the program, except for emergency situations or for use as a camera.
- Electrical outlets for charging phones are not guaranteed at your campsite.

Do NOT Bring to Camp:

- Outside food or beverages (other than water) are not allowed.
- Laser pointers, radios, music players and game systems are not allowed.
- Air mattresses are not allowed.

Please note: Groups that do not respect Zoo rules will be escorted from Zoo grounds by our park rangers. This may jeopardize your eligibility for future visits.

Phoenix Zoo Daytime Group Policies

Staying the next day after your Night Camp? Your most important duty is to always keep your campers with you while still having fun! Please review the following checklist prior to visiting the Phoenix Zoo with your group.

- Family members who wish to join camp participants after camp must pay regular entrance fees to the Zoo.
- A minimum chaperone ratio of one adult for every five campers must be maintained while on Zoo grounds.
- Chaperones cannot allow campers to wander the Zoo without supervision.
- Do not yell at or tease the animals, tap on or hit their exhibits or throw any objects.
- Respect all fences and boundaries. They are there for your safety and the safety of the animals.
- Do not climb or crawl on fences and boundaries.
- Food is yours to enjoy. Do not share with any of the animals, including free-roaming birds, squirrels, etc.

Please note: Groups that do not respect Zoo rules will be escorted from Zoo grounds by our park rangers. This may jeopardize your eligibility for future visits.

What to Pack for Your Night Camp

Please remember that families ***will carry their own belongings to the camp sleeping site.*** We recommend that you bring your gear in carry-on luggage with wheels, wagons or in easy-to-carry bags to make the hike as easy as possible.



Clothes: The Phoenix Zoo is in a “cold zone” and the temperature tends to be *five to 10 degrees cooler than surrounding areas.*

Night Camp is a rain or shine event, so make sure to check the weather for the date of your camp.

- Close-toed shoes
- Underclothing
- Socks
- Pants/shorts
- Shirt
- Pajamas
- Jacket, gloves and hat (Extra jackets are recommended during colder months)

Camp bedding/Tent: The Zoo does not provide any sort of bedding and you will be sleeping in an open grass area, so we recommend you bring the following to ensure a comfortable night’s sleep.

- Pillow
- Sleeping bag and/or extra blankets
- Sleeping pad and/or cot
- Tent (please limit the size of the tent to a 12x12 ft. space)

Toiletries: Paper towels and shower facilities are not available in the restrooms.

- Toothbrush/toothpaste
- Hairbrush
- Washcloth
- Deodorant

Miscellaneous: These items are not necessities but may be brought to Night Camp.

- **Camera:** Cameras are not allowed on night hikes but are allowed during other portions of the camp. Camera flash must be turned off while animals are present.
- **Refillable water bottle:** water jugs will be available for refills.
- **Insect Repellent:** You will be spending your evening outside.
- **Sunscreen:** Recommended if you are planning on spending the day at the Zoo after your camp.

Do NOT Bring to Camp:

- ⊗ Outside food or beverages (other than water) are not allowed.
- ⊗ Alcohol is prohibited.
- ⊗ Smoking or vaping is prohibited.
- ⊗ Food brought to the campsites attracts unwanted critters to your sleeping space.
- ⊗ Laser pointers, radios, music players and game systems are not allowed.
- ⊗ Air mattresses are not allowed.

Directions to the Phoenix Zoo

Please follow the instructions below for Night Camp drop-off and pick-up locations. Distribute this information to bus drivers and parents as needed.



The Zoo is located at **455 N. Galvin Parkway** in Phoenix, Arizona. The entrance to the Zoo is off Galvin Parkway in the heart of Papago Park, between McDowell and Van Buren.

Front entrance *drop-off* for Night Camp:

Your Night Camp experience will begin at 5:45 p.m. for overnight guests and 6:15 p.m. for twilight (evening only) guests. Please arrive at the Zoo with enough time to gather your group, ensure that everyone has all their belongings and camp gear and be ready to enter the Zoo with an instructor at your camp start time.

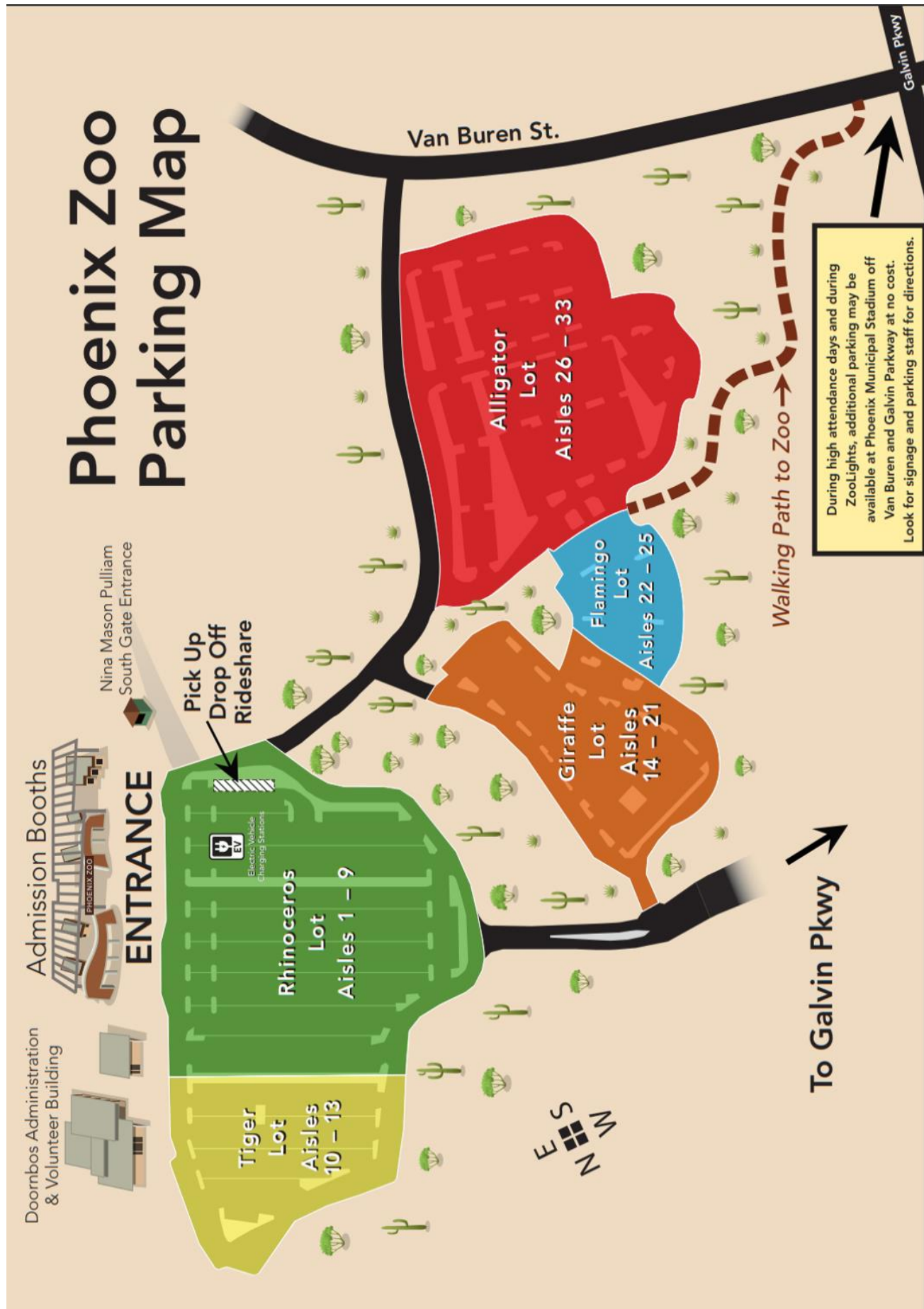
- **Personal vehicles:** Parents/guardians who are dropping off campers in personal vehicles should park in main parking lot spaces, unload their gear and meet the group at the appointed entrance.
- There will not be an opportunity to return to your vehicle overnight. Please bring everything you need overnight to the meeting spot.
- Avoid leaving any valuable items in your vehicle overnight.

Front entrance *pick-up* for Night Camp:

- **Personal vehicles:** Parents/guardians who are picking up campers in personal vehicles should park in main parking lot spaces and then meet their camper(s) in front of the Zoo at the front entrance.

Please note that the Twilight Camp (evening only) program ends at 9:15 p.m. and it will take some additional time for campers to walk to the meeting point.

Information on Your Camp Location

Lakeside Lawn

- The Lakeside Lawn is located in the front of the Phoenix Zoo, near the carousel. To see where your sleeping location is visit the [Zoo Maps](#) page.
- The lawn is a level grass area where tents will be set up. Families will choose the spot to set their tents up for the night.
- Please limit the size of your tent to a 12x12 ft. space. *Please note that depending on how many families attend the tents may need to be in close proximity.*
- Restrooms are located nearby in the plaza and the lights will stay on throughout the night. Showers are not available.
- There are no electrical outlets available.
- You will be sleeping in the tent you bring and set up. The Zoo does not provide any bedding for you. We highly suggest that you bring a sleeping pad or cot to ensure a comfortable night's sleep. Air mattresses are not permitted.
