WHY DO WE HAVE A DRESS CODE AT CAMP?

Modesty & Respect

As followers of Jesus, we aim to honor Him in all aspects of our lives, including how we present ourselves.

We expect campers, interns, counselors and staff to dress in a way that reflects self-respect and consideration for others. Our goal is to create an environment that focuses on faith, friendship, and fun

rather than outward appearance.

GENERAL

- No inappropriate logos, memes or words
- No super tight, form fitting or revealing clothes
- Tank tops must have a 2-inch strap
- No crop tops that show a bare midriff
- All shorts should be approximately mid-thigh in length
- Leggings can be worn with an oversized shirt that covers both the front and back.
- Mid-thigh length sliders may be worn under another pair of shorts to meet the mid-thigh shorts requirement.
- No undergarments should be seen at any time
- Closed-toed, athletic style shoes are required for ropes course and all field activities.

Safety & Practicality

Camp activities often include running, climbing, swimming, and games. The dress code ensures that clothing is appropriate for active participation without risk of tripping, overheating, or wardrobe malfunctions.

SWIMWEAR

Swimwear can only be worn during designated lake time. Students must change back into regular clothing before continuing to their next activity. All lake time is separated by gender.

SHOES

Swim shoes must be worn at all times while participating in lake activities. No substitutions (No sandals, flip-flops, crocs or Teva's)

BOYS

- Swim trunks must be approximately mid-thigh in length.
- With the exception of lake activities, a shirt must be worn at all times.

GIRLS

- A modest, one-piece bathing suit is required for lake time. If all you have is a two-piece swimsuit, you must wear a dark T-shirt while swimming.
- Swimsuits must always be covered by a dark T-shirt and mid-thigh shorts while walking to and from the beach.

It is at the discretion of the Camp Victory staff whether a clothing item is dress code compliant. If deemed inappropriate, campers will be asked to change. If suitable clothing is unavailable or the camper refuses to change, they will be given the baggiest, ugliest clothes available and dress like Adam Sandler for the remainder of the day.



SWIMWEAR

Swimsuits must always be covered by a dark T-shirt and mid-thigh shorts while walking to and from the beach.
