- 1. Camper Check-in is from 8:05 to 8:30 am on Monday, June 30 (Week 4: Day Camp) or Monday, July 7 (Week 5 Day Camp) at Selby Stadium parking lot. You should use Selby Stadium, 45 S Henry St, Delaware OH 43015 in your maps app.
- 2. Enter the parking lot from the South entrance, and weave through the line as designated. The North entrance will be exit only.
- 3. We will be receiving your camper at the back of the lot. Please be patient as we will be receiving 100 campers each day.
- 4. Please have your camper stay in the car until we check them in. Do not allow them to walk through the parking lot.
- 5. Camper Check-out is daily from 4:30 pm to 5:00 pm. They should be picked up in the same place you dropped them off, Selby Stadium parking lot. Again, we will not allow campers to walk through the parking lot. You must drive through the line and come to the back to check them out.
- 6. Please log into the OWL Camp Portal to confirm you have listed all individuals authorized to pick up your camper. Anyone picking up campers MUST be on the "Pickup Authorization" list and have a picture ID (ie... driver's license).
- 7. It would be extremely helpful to have a **sign** in the windshield with your **camper's name** on it for pickup purposes. If you could, please print something large enough to read from a car length (or two) away and display in your windshield at pickup.
- 8. Campers should eat breakfast at home every day, before coming to camp.
- 9. NEW for This Year: Campers must bring a packed lunch each day.
 Lunch will take place at 12:00 PM, and students will no longer eat in the campus dining hall.
- 10. As in previous years, campers should also bring a **closed**, **spill-proof water bottle**.
- 11. We recommend some type of backpack to carry items and water bottles.
- 12. Bring rain gear (just-in-case). We still go to classes in the rain. You can bring an umbrella, rain jacket or poncho.
- 13. Leaves of Absence will not be permitted except for medical emergencies.
- 14. If your camper requires a lifesaving medical device (ie... epi pen), please be sure it is in their backpack.
- 15. Please be sure to review the rules and regulations with your camper before bringing them to camp. This was a requirement on the registration portal.
- 16. If a course the camper is scheduled for requires any special preparation or materials, we will notify you. Please do not purchase any materials without prior notification.
- 17. The free t-shirts will be distributed during pickup on Monday.
