For the safety and wellbeing of ALL at camp, no campers (including those 18+), may have their electronic devises while at camp. **Definition of an electronic devise implies**: a devise that has access to WIFI, data service, or is able to transfer data.

This includes devices such as <u>cell phones</u>, <u>smart watches</u>, <u>tablets</u>, <u>laptops</u>, <u>gaming</u> <u>consoles</u>, <u>etc</u>. Campers will be asked to leave their devises safely AT HOME. Devises that arrive at camp will be collected by camp staff, labeled & stored safely and returned at the time of departure. Any devises HIDDEN in luggage will also be confiscated.

Please understand that this means campers will not be able to text, call, be tracked, etc during their time here as a camper, in a group living situation.

If you are a group leader, please notify your campers' parents about this policy.

Parents may contact group leaders to check on the status of their camper. In the event of an emergency, parents may call the camp office directly. Campers may write letters & postcards. Parents may "pre-mail" letters so that their camper receives mail while at camp.
