Please Keep in Mind,

Camp is full of fun activities, the majority of which take place outside. Please anticipate anything and everything getting dirty. Bring clothes and shoes you do not mind being ruined. Bring a plastic bag for wet or dirty clothes. It is recommended that you bring only one soft sided suitcase or duffle. Bring loose bedding in a trash bag with your camper's name written on the outside.

Kenbrook is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please put your name on everything! It is almost guaranteed that something will be misplaced at some point during time at camp. Lost and found will be displayed throughout the week for campers to retrieve and at the end of the week parents will also be able to look through any lost and found items that their camper might have lost.

What to Bring:

- Bible, Notebook, Pen/Pencils
- 1 Bedding Set: Sheets, Blankets, & Pillow
- Swimsuit (modest, one piece for the ladies)
- Sleeping bag for camp out night
- Pair Tennis Shoes (closed toed shoes)
- Water Bottle
- Pair of Water Shoes and/or sports sandal with heel strap
- Bath towel, washcloth, & beach towel
- 7 Shorts, 1 Pair of pants

- 1 Laundry Bag or Trash Bag
- Sweater or Sweatshirt for cold nights
- 7 days' worth of Socks & Undergarments
- Pajamas
- Jacket and/or Windbreaker
- Raincoat and/or Poncho with hood
- Toiletries (hairbrush, soap, toothbrush, feminine products, etc.)
- Sunscreen & Insect Repellent
- Pair of Shower Shoes (flip flops, Crocs etc.)
- Shower Caddy or Bag
- Flashlight with extra batteries

Optional Items:

- Books
- Sunglasses
- Camera (camera only; no phones)
- Hat/cap (for Krew campers)

What <u>Not</u> to Bring:

- Skin Tight clothing or clothing where undergarments are visible (including cut t-shirts)
- Shorts with less than a 3" inseam, leggings or tights unless covered with other clothing
- Crop tops, spaghetti string shirts, tube tops, crop tops, bikinis, or speedos
- Cell phones, radios, electronic games
- Cigarettes, alcohol, drugs

- Fishing Pole
- Playing cards
- Swimming goggles
- Inappropriate or pornographic materials
- Clothing with vulgar language/ inappropriate slogans and pictures
- Pets or other living creatures
- Candles, Fireworks, or other flammables
- Snacks or drinks
- Knives, guns, or other weaponry
- Cash, cards, etc.

Camper Mail:

If you are planning to send mail to your camper you have three options.

1. Snail mail! Be mindful of mail delay, and send to:

Simply log into the account that you registered your camper on, find the communication tool to send emails to campers, write your email, and we will print it out to deliver at the next lunch time. Please note that letters received at or around lunch time on Friday will not be delivered.
