


Go through Crosbyton. Past the city park and cemetery.

Make the first left (north) on F.M. 2591 at the bottom of the hill. There are 4 historical markers on the NorthEast corner of the intersection of 62/82 and F.M. 2591. The camp gate is on the left side of the road once you cross White River bridge.

## AGREEMENTS

- Use your walking feet at all times
- Wear socks and shoes at all times
- Wear a t-shirt, no sleeveless shirts
- Don't forget your sunscreen and insect repellent

- Do not climb or play on the banisters or walls of Bridwell
