IT'S TIME TO *Pack!*

WHAT TO BRING:

- Comfortable, casual clothing
- Light hoodie & rain jacket
- Pair of sneakers & a pair of sandals/flip flops
- Bedding/pillow for twin size bed
- All necessary toiletries
- Sunscreen & bug spray
- Towel (for shower & pool)
- Swimwear
- Bible, journal, pen
- Refillable water bottle

Reminder: Buddy camp means the "Buddy" stays and experiences camp alongside their camper for the whole time! Both camper + buddy will want to pack bedding.

Arrival Day

5:00 - 6:00 PM

If you arrive earlier than 5pm, you'll need to wait in your car and let the excitement build! Staff will begin registration promptly at 5:00PM. Come hungry! We'll eat dinner together first thing.

- Follow the signs as you arrive - be prepared to stop! Remain in your car and our registration staff will greet you. They will let you & your camper know your cabin assignment, give you your camp shirts, and confirm payment has been made.
- You'll get settled into your cabin, put your new camp shirts on, and make your way to the playground while we wait on everyone to arrive!
- At 6:15PM we will meet around the flag pole to gather and pray for our dinner.

Reminder: you will be placed in cabins with campers and buddies of your same genders.
Ex: moms with daughters, dads with sons, etc.

Departure

First thing Saturday morning, you will pack up your belongings and load them in your car before we continue the rest of our camp programming.

We will conclude our time together at lunch at noon on Saturday.

Swimming

The NGCC pool will always have an appropriate number of American Red Cross Certified Lifeguards on duty.

Campers are only allowed to swim in the deep end if they pass the swim test (without the use of any flotation device) and our lifeguards feel they are a confident swimmer.

We have a shallow end and splash pad for all our still-learning swimmers!
