

## Brimmer and May Summer Camp Behavior Management Statement

## Please read and sign the following statement with your child:

It is the goal of Brimmer Summer Camp to provide a healthy, safe, secure environment for all campers. Brimmer Summer Camp seeks to instill the values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility in both its staff and its campers.

Children who attend the program are expected to follow these behavior guidelines set by the camp and reinforced by their parent/guardian and counselors, and to interact appropriately in a group setting.

The following behaviors are unacceptable and may result in the immediate suspension of a camper for the remainder of the current day, the next day, and if necessary, for a longer period of time, at the Camp Director's discretion.

- Endangering the health and safety of others
- Biting or striking another camper or staff member
- Bullying another camper or staff member
- Using profanity, vulgarity, obscenity, or otherwise abusive language
- Stealing or damaging Brimmer and May and/or personal Property
- Leaving the camp program or grounds without permission
- Disrupting the program
- Acting in a lewd manner
- Refusing to follow the Behavior Guidelines of the camp

If any of these behaviors persist, it may lead to expulsion at the camp director's discretion. No refunds will be given for children who are asked to leave camp for any reason related to behavior management.
