Instrument Rental

Students must have access to an instrument, accessories such as reeds or strings where applicable, and music stand (for non-pianists) in order to take lessons. If you are interested in renting an instrument, we recommend The Music and Art Center located at 839 Beacon Street, Newton Centre. This is also a convenient location for instruments that need routine repair. Please contact Luca with questions or concerns about instrument rental.

Music

Lesson material (books, sheet music) will be assigned by a student's teacher. Most music can be purchased from a music store. Families are responsible for purchasing sheet music and other materials as needed.

Lesson Format

All lessons in 2020/21 will be held online through Zoom or a videoconferencing application of the instructor's choice. Students and teachers should follow Brimmer and May's guidelines for videoconferencing.

Financial Aid

If you indicated that you receive financial aid from Brimmer for tuition during the registration process, please pay the deposit. Your balance will be adjusted at the same percentage of aid received, up to 50% for the **first instrument**. Families will receive an email that it has been adjusted. You may then log on to your account and pay the balance. Financial aid is limited; please apply early. Financial Aid is not available for a second instrument of study.

Recitals

At the end of the school year, students in Grades 2-12 who wish to share their talents may perform at a recital scheduled for Sunday, April 25, 2021. A recital for our young musicians in grades Pre-K through Grade 1 will be on Wednesday, April 28, 2021. We expect that these recitals will take place over Zoom.
